BLUE JACKETS TEAM NOTES

- ★ Columbus (1-1-0) finished the season series against Colorado (1-1-0) following tonight's regulation loss.
- ★ The Jackets moved to 3-2-0 in the last five contests of the season.
- ★ CBJ fell to 10-5-2 in the last 17 home games in 2024-25. The team has recorded points in 18 of the past 24 home contests (14-6-4) as well as in 23 of the last 30 played at home (18-7-5).
- ★ The club has recorded 239 goals (not including SO goals) in 2024-25, the most through 73 games in a single season in franchise history, ahead of the 236 scored in 2021-22.
- ★ Tonight's attendance was a sellout crowd of 18,392. The club has seen sellouts in eight of the last 12 games played at Nationwide Arena since Jan. 25 (17,939 avg.) and 13 sellouts total in 2024-25.

BLUE JACKETS PLAYER NOTES

- ★ RW Zach Aston-Reese (5-11-16, 73 GP) scored his first goal since Nov. 15 vs. Pittsburgh and now sits four points from 100 for his NHL career (47-49-96, 383 GP).
- ★ D Dante Fabbro (7-16-23, 60 GP) has collected assists in each of his past four games (2-5-7) after registering an assist tonight. He is one point-shy of tying his single season career high (3-21-24 in 66 GP with NSH in 2021-22).
- ★ C **Boone Jenner** (6-12-18, 18 GP) scored to stretch his points streak to six-straight games (6-3-9), tying his career high (3x, MR: Jan. 8-21, 2024 with 4-3-7). He has posted 8-7-15 with points in 12 of 18 career games against Colorado, including points in his last seven-straight games played (3-4-7) as well as nine of his past 11 overall (5-7-12).
- ★ RW **Kent Johnson** (22-28-50, 60 GP) assisted for the second-straight games (0-4-4) and became the third Blue Jacket to reach the 50-point plateau for 2024-25.
- ★ D Jack Johnson (0-6-6, 39 GP) assisted for his first points since Feb. 8 vs. NY Rangers (0-1-1).

- ★ C Sean Monahan (17-32-49, 46 GP) scored and has collected 3-2-5 in two-straight contests after tonight. He has 3-5-8 in his last four games as well as points in eight of his last nine contests (4-12-16) and seven multi-point efforts in his last 12 games (8-16-24). He improved his career mark against Colorado to 11-17-28 in 27 games played, including 4-4-8 in his last four overall as well as 5-10-15 in 12 career home contests.
