January 26, 2025 – CALGARY FLAMES [2] vs. WINNIPEG JETS [5]

The Calgary Flames finished off a back-to-back set on Sunday in Winnipeg against the Jets. The home side would register the only goal of the first with Kyle Connor giving the Jets a 1-0 lead. In the second, Winnipeg would double their advantage before a MacKenzie Weegar powerplay marker drew the Flames within one. Gabriel Vilardi would respond for the Jets to give Winnipeg a 3-1 advantage through 40. In the final frame, a pair of Jets goals would be split up by Nazem Kadri's 17th of the season, but the Flames fell 5-2.

TONIGHTS STORYLINES & STATS

This is the first of two meetings this season between the Flames and Capitals. Calgary went 0-1-1 against Washington in 2023-24.

This is a Pacific Division versus Metropolitan Division matchup; the Flames have a record of 6-3-0 against Metropolitan Division teams and a record of 9-5-5 against Eastern Conference opponents.

HOWLIN' FOR YOU:

With his win on Saturday against Minnesota, Dustin Wolf improved his career record to 26-14-3 to tie Tom Barrasso for the ninth-most wins by an American rookie goaltender. John Gibson (t-2nd: 37), Alex Nedeljkovic (t-2nd: 37) and Jeremy Swayman (8th; 30) are the only active goaltenders among that list that sit higher. In recording his 26th career win, Wolf also moves within one victory of tying Dan Vladar (27) for the second most by a Flames rookie goaltender. Mike Vernon tops the list with 39.

ROONEY 300:

Kevin Rooney enters play tonight having skated in 299 career NHL contests and has a chance to skate in his 300th NHL game tonight. The Canton, MA native made his NHL debut on March 2nd, 2017 against tonight's opponent the Washington Capitals as a member of the New Jersey Devils. Rooney joined the Flames organization in July of 2023, and has skated in 89 contests in Flames colours, with nine points from six goals and three helpers.

CALGARY WASHINGTON TIES:

Capitals forward Andrew Mangiapane spent seven seasons with the Calgary Flames and is set to face his former team for the first time. Mangiapane was selected in the sixth round (166th overall) in the 2015 NHL Draft by Calgary, and played in 417 contests in Flames colours, scoring 109 goals along with 106 assists for 215 points. The 28-year-old also skated in 27 playoff outings for Calgary, registering 12 points from six goals and six assists. He was traded to Washington this past summer in exchange for a 2025 second-round pick.

Capitals goaltender Logan Thompson was born in Calgary and played his U18 hockey for the Calgary Buffaloes before moving on to Junior 'A' with the Grand Prairie Storm and eventually the WHL's Brandon Wheat Kings.

DOMESWEET DOME:

The Calgary Flames get set to play six of their seven games remaining before the NHL Four Nations tournament at home, starting tonight by welcoming the Washington Capitals. The Flames enter tonight's contest with the league's ninth-best home points-percentage at .688 thanks to a 15-6-3 record at the Scotiabank Saddledome. Calgary has outscored their opponents 71-63 at home so far in 2024-25 with Jonathan Huberdeau leading the Flames with 11 home-ice goals. Following tonight, Calgary closes out the week by hosting the Anaheim Ducks on Thursday and the Detroit Red Wings on Saturday.

RAZZLE DAZZLE:

With his goal on Saturday in Minnesota, Rasmus Andersson recorded his 43rd career goal and surpassed Dougie Hamilton and Noah Hanifin for the ninth most by a defenseman in franchise history. Andersson already ranks as the highest-scoring Swedish-born rearguard in Flames franchise history. Andersson's 503 games played also put him 14 games away from tying Paul Reinhart (517) for the seventh-most in Flames history.

FUTURE WATCH:

Flames 2024 first round pick Zayne Parekh recorded his second hat trick in his last four games on Sunday against the Ottawa 67's and was named the OHL player of the week. The 18-year-old is on a six-game point streak with nine goals and seven assists for 16 points since January 10th. Parekh's 21 goals lead all OHL defencemen and the Nobleton, ON native recently became the highest-scoring defenceman in Saginaw Spirit franchise history.



Flames 2024 third round pick Henry Mews currently leads the OHL in assists as a defenceman with 48 through 45 games played and has recorded four helpers in his last four games. Mews is also the OHL's highest scoring defenceman, posting 60 points, with fellow Flames prospect Zayne Parekh one point behind him.

A pair of fellow Flames prospects find themselves inside the top 20 in OHL scoring along with Mews and Parekh. Kingston forward Jacob Battaglia (27-35 – 62 in 44GP) and Brampton forward Luke Misa (25-34 – 59 in 44GP) are also over a point-per game so far in 2024-25.

HEY DID YOU KNOW?

Capitals forward Andrew Mangiapane and Flames defenceman Rasmus Andersson were teammates on the OHL's Barrie Colts for two seasons in junior from 2014 to 2016.
