AT A GLANCE

HOME SWEDE HOME FOR THE HOLIDAYS

Forward **Adrian Kempe** returns home from the Kings' three-game road-trip last week after scoring his 12th and 13th goals of the season on Thursday in Tampa. In doing so, Kempe leapfrogged fellow 29-year-old winger **Kevin Fiala** (12 G) for the most by a Kings skater this season. With four points (3-1=4) in his last five games, Kempe is the Kings' outright leader in goals (13) assists (17) and points (13-17=30). Of his 13 goals, three have been in overtime and five stood as game-winning goals, both of which also lead the team. He looks to add to those totals tomorrow against the Columbus Blue Jackets, a team against whom he has notched three points (0-3=3) in his last two home games, dating back to Feb. 20, 2024.

WITHOUT A DOUGHT

Defenseman **Drew Doughty** skates into his second home game since picking up his seventh and eighth assists of the season as part of his 134th career multi-point outing in the Kings' 6-0 shutout of the Chicago Blackhawks on Saturday, Dec. 6. Doughty (162-534=696) now sits four points shy of 700 in his career and can narrow that gap tomorrow night against the Columbus Blue Jackets. The native of London, Ontario, has recorded 23 of his 534 career assists across his 37 career matchups with the Metropolitan Division club, the most helpers versus Columbus by any skater in Kings history. Doughty's 23 assists and 32 career points (9-23=32) each rank as the 10th most against the Blue Jackets by any blueliner in NHL history in their respective category.

THE OHIO ST(REAK)

The Kings return to Crypto.com Arena for their sixth back-to-back scenario this season beginning with Columbus on Monday. The Kings carry an eight-game point streak (6-0-2) against the Blue Jackets into tomorrow's matchup, dating back to March 4, 2022. Furthermore, LA has won eight of their last 10 against the Blue Jackets (8-2-0) at Crypto.com Arena. It is tied for the third-longest active point streak against any one opponent for the Kings and is one of six such streaks of at least six games in length. The Kings are joined by the Florida Panthers (9 GP) and Vancouver Canucks (8 GP) as the only three teams in the league with an active point streak of at least eight games in length against the Blue Jackets.
