- Forward **Jared Wright** (0-1=1) notched his first career assist in his professional debut, helping the Ontario Reign defeat the Colorado Eagles by a score of 4-2 on Wednesday, April 16.
- The Reign finished the regular season with an overall record of 43-25-3-1 and 90 points, securing the third seed in the AHL's Pacific Division. The team will host all games of the best-of-three series against the sixth-seed San Jose Barracuda.
- Reign forward **Taylor Ward** (1-0=1) recorded his first career goal in his NHL debut on April 17. Ward is the second alumnus of the University of Nebraska-Omaha to play for the Kings, joining **Scott Parse**, who recorded 30 points (14-16=30) in 73 games played for LA from 2009-10 through 2011-12.

- Forward **Ryan Conmy** led the University of New Hampshire in points, finishing the season with 33 (15-18=33) in 34 games. After recording an 11-game point streak with six goals and eight assists for 14 points (Nov. 9-Jan. 4) en route to setting new career highs in his sophomore season, Conmy was named to the Hobey Baker Ballot for the second consecutive occasion.
- Goaltender **Hampton Slukynsky** finished his freshman season at Western Michigan University tied for the seventh lowest goals against average (GAA) with a 1.92 over 23 appearances on the campaign.

- Forward **Liam Greentree** finished the regular season third in the Ontario Hockey League (OHL) in total points (49-70=119) behind only teammate **Ilya Protas** (50-74=124) and Saginaw's **Michael Misa** (62-72=134).
- Through 189 regular season games played, Greentree's 254 career points (110-144=254), the Spitfires' captain are the seventh most in franchise history. He is one of three Windsor players to have recorded at least 250 career points for the team since the year 2000, joining **Ryan Ellis** (73-240=313), who played 226 games from 2007-2011, and **Taylor Hall** (123-157=280), who wore a Spitfires sweater for 183 contests from 2007-2010.
- Goaltender **Carter George** maintained a .909 SV% through 47 appearances on the year, the seventh best among 43 OHL goalies with at least 10 regular season games played.

Slukynsky was named to the Frozen Four All-Tournament Team and is the first freshman goaltender to backstop a team to the national title since 2009, when **Kieran Millan** did so for the Boston University Terriers.
