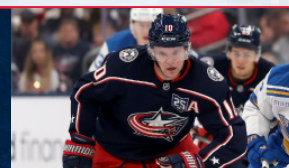
MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ The home team has won 10 of the past 11 games in the series dating back to Mar. 1, 2020, including nine-straight.
- ★ Columbus has won five consecutive home games, including the last three after regulation (two in SO).
- ★ The teams have combined for seven-plus goals in seven of the last eight games dating back to Dec. 14, 2021, including each of the past four.
- ★ Three of the last five meetings and four of the past seven in the series have been decided after regulation.
- ★ Six of the past eight matchups in the series have been decided by a single goal.
- ★ The clubs have combined for five shorthanded goals in the last nine games overall.
- ★ CBJ have scored on 5-of-22 power play chances over the last six meetings overall (22.7 pct.) and have scored a power play goal in each of the past two contests at Nationwide Arena (2-of-9; 22.2 pct.).



JACKET TO WATCH - LW Dmitri Voronkov

Has collected 3-2-5 with two multi-point efforts in five career GP vs. Vancouver. Tallied 1-2-3 in the most recent meeting earlier this season on Nov. 8, 2025.



CANUCK TO WATCH - RW Brock Boeser

Has 6-6-12 with four multi-point efforts in 12 GP vs. Columbus. Has collected goals in each of his last four games (6-3-9) and has points in five of his last six contests (6-5-11).



TEAM NOTES

- ★ Columbus won its second consecutive contest with the 5-3 victory over Calgary on Tuesday. The win kicked off a stretch of seven-of-eight games played at Nationwide Arena from Jan. 13-28.
- ★ The Jackets have scored the first goal in 11 of the last 15 contests and 14 of the past 20. The team ranks fifth-T in the NHL in games scoring first in 2025-26 (26).
- ★ Columbus blueliners combined for 2-3-5 in the win over the Flames. The club leads the NHL in goals by defensemen and ranks fourth in points with 36-82-118 in 46 contests.
- ★ The Blue Jackets rank fourth in the league in faceoff percentage since Dec. 13 (53.7 pct. in 15 GP).
- ★ CBJ are in the middle of a stretch of 10-of-14 played against the Western Conference from Jan. 6-31.

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ **C Charlie Coyle** has tallied goals in consecutive games (3-1-4) after posting his fourth effort of three or more points this season with 2-1-3 on Tuesday.
- ★ **C Adam Fantilli** has collected assists in three of the past four games (0-3-3) and four of the last six (0-4-4).
- ★ **C Boone Jenner**, who has posted 3-5-8 in the last nine games after notching his first career Gordie Howe hat trick vs. Calgary, sits one assist shy from becoming the fourth Blue Jacket to record 200 career assists (207-199-406, 773 GP).
- ★ **RW Kirill Marchenko** collected an assist vs. Calgary and has recorded points in nine of the last 11 contests (6-6-12).
- ★ **RW Mathieu Olivier** recorded eight hits vs. the Flames and leads the NHL with 49 since returning from injury on Dec. 28.
- ★ **LW Dmitri Voronkov** has collected 3-2-5 in the last seven games and has points in eight of the past 12 contests (4-4-8).
- ★ **D Zach Werenski** leads NHL blueliners in goals (17) and multi-point efforts (17) after posting 1-2-3 on Tuesday. He has registered points in 22 of his past 26 contests overall to lead NHL blueliners in goals, assists (tied), points and points-per-game since Nov. 13 (13-26-39, 1.50). He has also posted points in each of his past 15 games at NWA, ranking fourth among all NHL skaters in scoring at home since Oct. 29 (11-18-29, 11 multi-point efforts).
