### KINGS NOTES

- Forward **Samuel Helenius** (1-0=1) scored his second goal of the season, extending his point streak (1-2=3) to a career-long third game, dating back exactly one week ago to the Kings' win over the Rangers on Jan. 20 at Crypto.com Arena.
- Forward **Andrei Kuzmenko** (1-0=1) scored his 11th goal of the season tonight, his first career goal (1-1=2) in six games played against the Detroit Red Wings.
- The tally was Kuzmenko's team-leading sixth of the year on the man-advantage and marked his third game-winning goal (GWG) of the campaign, which trails only **Adrian Kempe** (5 GWG) for the most by a Kings skater.
- Forward **Corey Perry** (1-0=1) also scored *his* 11th goal of the campaign, extending his point streak to a fifth consecutive appearance (2-3=5), dating back to Jan. 10 in Edmonton. Perry played in his 1,432nd career regular season NHL game this evening at Little Caesars Arena, tying **Mike Gartner** (1,432 GP) for 34th most in League history.
- Forward **Jeff Malott** (0-1=1) notched his fourth assist of the campaign on Helenius' goal this evening, the third straight game in which Malott has provided a helper (0-3=3), dating back to Jan. 20 versus New York. This is the Burlington, Ontario, native's first career point streak of such length.
- Forward **Adrian Kempe** (0-1=1) recorded his team-leading 23rd assist and 40th point (17-23=40) of the campaign with a primary set-up on Kuzmenko's game-winning tally. Kempe extends his point streak to a fourth game (2-2=4), dating back to Jan. 17 in Anaheim.
- Forward **Kevin Fiala** (0-1=1) notched his 19th helper of the season and marked his sixth consecutive visit to Detroit with a point (2-8=10), dating back to Feb. 27, 2020, as a member of the Minnesota Wild.
- Defenseman **Drew Doughty** skated in his 40th career contest against the Detroit Red Wings, breaking a tie with **Mattias Norstrom** (39 GP) for the most games played against Detroit by a defenseman in franchise history.
- Goaltender **Anton Forsberg** made 26 saves on 27 shots to earn his ninth win of the campaign and improve his career record against the Detroit Red Wings to 4-0-1.
