# **PLAYERS TO WATCH**

## JEAN-GABRIEL PAGEAU #44

Islanders forward Jean-Gabriel Pageau has four points (one goal, three assists) in his last five games, and scored his 14th goal of the season on Tuesday against the Capitals. The 32-year-old has 42 points (14 goals, 28 assists) in 78 games this season, a career-best in assists and one point shy of his career-best in points, 43, set in the 2015-16 season. Pageau's 14 goals are also the most he has scored in a single campaign since 2021-22 (18). The Ottawa, ON native has helped the Islanders capture points eight of the last ten times that he has found the scoresheet since Feb. 27.

scored to help the Islanders capture a point in the shootout. The

Islanders will look to finish the season with a 12-10-4 record

against Metropolitan Division opponents, and can improve to

5-1-1 on the road against the Blue Jackets since March 2022.

# **BY THE NUMBERS**

Tonight, forward Simon Holmstrom can skate in his 200th career NHL game. He will become the sixth Swedish-born player in franchise history to play 200 games in an Islanders sweater, and the first since Kenny Jonsson (1995-04).

Kyle Palmieri can skate in his 900th NHL game tonight, becoming the 15th member of his 2009 NHL Draft class to do so. Palmieri will be one of four active New Yorkers in the NHL with 900 career games played, joining Patrick Kane, Nick Foligno and Zach Bogosian.

#### **ADAM FANTILLI #19**

Blue Jackets forward Adam Fantilli has five goals in his last three games, including the game-winner in Columbus' visit to Washington, D.C. on Sunday. Fantilli, 20, has set career-highs in all three scoring categories this season, with 53 points (30 goals, 23 assists) in 81 games. The Nobleton, ON native is second on the Blue Jackets in goals, and his eight goals since April 1 are tied with David Pastrnak for the most in the NHL in that span. Fantilli found the back of the net and recorded the game-deciding goal in the shootout when these teams last met on March 24.


