GAME NOTES

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Tonight is the first of three games the Stars will play against the Avalanche this season and the only time the two teams will face off in Dallas this year. The teams will next meet on Jan. 18, 2025 in Denver.
- The Stars enter tonight's matchup against Colorado with an 8-2-0 record while playing at the American Airlines Center this season.
 - Only one of Dallas' "home" losses this season was American Airlines Center, with the first coming at Nokia Arena in Tampere, Finland.
- Dallas' .800 points percentage at home this year was the third-best mark in the NHL entering play Thursday.
- The Stars have allowed only 20 goals in home games this year, which was tied with Los Angeles for the best mark in the NHL entering play Thursday. Their 2.00 goals-against per game at home this season was also tied with Los Angeles and Toronto for first in the NHL.
- Dallas has gone 22-for-25 on the penalty kill at home this year. Their 88 percent success rate when play a man down at home this year was the third-best mark in the NHL entering play Thursday.
- The Stars have allowed only 2.67 goals against per game this season, which was the sixth-best mark in the NHL entering play Thursday. Dallas has allowed two or fewer goals in 12 of the 21 games that they have played this year.

SNOW PLOWS

- Dallas is 68-67-21 all-time vs. Colorado, including a 42-23-13 mark at home.
- Jamie Benn has four points (1-3-4) in his last four games against the Avalanche.
- Casey DeSmith is 2-O-1 in his career against the Avalanche, posting a .934 save percentage and a 2.61 goals-against average in those games.
- Former Av Matt Duchene has 17 points (12-5–17) in 16 career games against Colorado.
- Mason Marchment has eight points (2-6–8) in eight career games against the Avalanche.
- Jason Robertson has 13 points (5-8–13) in 11 career games against Colorado.
- **Tyler Seguin** has 47 points (25-22-47) in 41 career games against the Avalanche and enters tonight's game riding a five-game point streak against Colorado.

• Logan Stankoven has recorded a point (one goal and one assist) in each of the two career games he has played against Colorado.

DOUBLE DUTCH

- Matt Duchene enters tonight's game having totaled 26 points (12-14-26) in 21 games this season, which includes recording nine multi-point efforts this year.
- Entering play Thursday, **Duchene** was ranked in the top 10 among Canadian skaters this season in goals (tied fourth) and points (tied eighth).
- With 26 points in 21 games, **Duchene** has already reached 40 percent of his total scoring from last year (25-40–65) despite only being 25.6 percent of the way through the 2024-25 season.
- Duchene has recorded a point in 15 of the 21 games he has played this season and enters tonight's game leading the Stars in both goals (12), assists (14) and points (26).
- When **Duchene** has been on the ice this season during 5-on-5 play, the Stars have outscored their opponents 18-9 according to Natural Stat Trick.

TILTING THE ICE

- **Thomas Harley** has recorded a plus-15 even strength on-ice goal differential this season, which was tied for the eighthbest mark in the NHL this year entering play Thursday.
- In all, **Harley** has been on the ice for 31 even-strength goals this season, which was tied for third in the NHL entering play Thursday, trailing only Washington's Rasmus Sandin (33) and Dylan Strome (32).
- Among NHL defensemen this year, **Miro Heiskanen** ranked in the top 10 in both even strength on-ice goal differential (10, tied 10th) and even strength on-ice goals for (27, tied 13th) entering play Thursday.
- Since Nov. 11, both Harley and Heiskanen have recorded a plus-9 even strength on-ice goal differential, which was tied with Washington's Rasmus Sandin for the best mark in the league during that span.
- Entering play Thursday, Mason Marchment (plus-12) and Tyler Seguin (plus-11) were tied for eighth and 11th, respectively, among all NHL forwards this season in even strength on-ice goal differential.

SETTING THE PACE

- With 61 regular-season games remaining, five different Stars skaters are pacing to set career highs in scoring this year: Colin Blackwell, Matt Duchene, Ilya Lyubushkin, Mason Marchment and Sam Steel.
- Duchene is currently pacing to finish the year with 47 goals, 55 assists and 102 points, which would all be career highs for the 16-year veteran.
 - If he were to maintain that pace, his 2024-25 season would be the sixth-highest scoring season in franchise history.
 - Forty-five goals would also be the sixth-highest total by a Stars skater in a single season in franchise history.
- Marchment is currently pacing to finish the year with 28 goals, 53 assists and 81 points, all of which would be career highs. His 20 points this year are already 37.7 percent of his career high of 53 (22-31-53) that he reached last season in 81 games.
- Blackwell (10-14–24), Lyubushkin (0-23–23) and Steel (8-24–32) are all on pace to finish the regular season with career highs in both assists and points.
- Wyatt Johnston (35), Esa Lindell (23) and Brendan Smith (18) are all pacing to finish the 2024-25 season with a career high in assists.
- Additionally, rookie Logan Stankoven is pacing to finish the year with 43 assists and 59 points. Forty-three assists would be the sixth-most by a rookie in franchise history.

LIND, LAUGH, LOVE

- Esa Lindell has recorded eight points (2-6-8) in 20 games this season and enters tonight's contest ranked third among Stars defensemen in scoring.
- Lindell enters tonight's game one point shy of totaling 200 career points. When he reaches the milestone, he will become the 13th defenseman from the 2012 NHL Draft class to total 200 points.
- He will also become the 49th player and 13th defenseman in franchise history to record 200 points with the Stars.
- Lindell is one goal away from tying Philippe Boucher (52) for 10th in franchise history in goals scored by a defenseman.
- He is averaging 3:22 of shorthanded ice time per game this season, which was tied for the fifth-highest mark in the NHL entering play Thursday.

FACING OFF

- Jamie Benn has gone 115-for-183 at the faceoff dot this season. His 62.8 percent success rate was the fourth-best mark in the NHL this year among skaters to take at least 20 draws entering play Thursday.
- Benn is one of five players this season to take at least 10 draws while only losing one or fewer and the only player to do so twice.
- Benn first went a perfect 16-for-16 at the faceoff dot on Nov. 7 against the Chicago Blackhawks. It marked the first time in his career that he has taken at least 16 draws in a game without losing one.

- Since the NHL began tracking faceoffs in 1997-98, **Benn** became just the sixth player to go undefeated at the faceoff dot when taking at least 16 draws.
- Benn then went 10-for-11 at the faceoff dot in Dallas' game on Nov. 18 against the Anaheim Ducks for a 90.9 percent success rate.

FIRST THING'S FIRST

- The Stars have opened the scoring in 57.1 percent of the games that they have played this season, recording the first goal of the game in 12 of their 21 games.
- Dallas has gone on to win 10 of the 12 games that they have scored first in. Their 10 wins when scoring first were tied for the second-best mark in the league this season entering play Thursday.
- Additionally, the Stars' .833 win percentage when scoring first this year was the fourth-best mark in the NHL entering play Thursday.
- Dallas' first goal in their game on Nov. 25 came on their first shot of the game. **Tyler Seguin** opened the scoring 18 seconds into the game, which tied Michael Kesselring (0:18 on Nov. 7 w/ UTA) for the second-fastest game-opening goal this season behind Nathan Walker (0:11 on Nov. 21 w/ STL) according to NHL Stats.
 - The Stars have scored on their first shot of the game three times this season according to NHL Stats.

ONE FOR THE HISTORY BOOKS

- Jake Oettinger's next shutout will be the 12th of his career, which will tie Jon Casey for the sixth-most in franchise history. He is also just two wins away from tying Don Beaupre (126) for seventh on the franchise's all-time wins list.
- Miro Heiskanen is five assists shy of tying Dennis Hextall (216) for 23rd on the franchise's all-time assists list. He's also six assists shy of trying Brad Maxwell (217) for 7th on the all-time assists list by defensemen.
- Jason Robertson is six points away from tying Tom McCarthy (333) for 24th on the franchise's all-time scoring list.
- Matt Duchene is nine points away from recording his 100th point with the Stars.
- Esa Lindell is 10 games shy of tying Lou Nanne (635) for ninth on the franchise's all-time games played list by defensemen.

- Stars forward Matt Duchene was drafted by Colorado with the third pick in the 2009 NHL Draft, he played for Colorado from 2009-10 to 2017-18.
- Avalanche forward Joel Kiviranta played for the Dallas Stars from 2019-20 until the 2022-23 season.
- Avalanche forward Valeri Nichushkin played for the Dallas Stars from 2013-14 to 2015-16 then returned to Dallas for the 2018-19 season.
- Stars defenseman Matt Dumba and Avalanche forward Ross Colton both played for Tampa Bay during the 2023-24 season.
- Stars forward **Evgenii Dadonov** and Avalanche forward Jonathan Drouin played part of the 2022-23 season together with the Montreal Canadiens.
- Stars forward **Evgenii Dadonov** and Avalanche forward Parker Kelly played one game together as members of the Ottawa Senators during the 2020-21 season.
- Stars defenseman Ilya Lyubushkin and Avalanche forward Casey Mittelstadt were teammates in Buffalo during the 2022-23 season.
- Stars defenseman **Brendan Smith** and Avalanche forward Miles Wood skated together for the Devils during the 2022-23 season.
- Stars defenseman Matt Dumba and Avalanche defenseman Calvin de Haan played together with the Lightning for the 2023-24 season.
- Stars forward **Sam Steel** and Avalanche defenseman Josh Manson both played for the Ducks from 2018-19 to the 2021-22 season.
- Stars defenseman Brendan Smith and Avalanche goaltender Alexander Georgiev were members of the Rangers from 2016-17 to 2020-21. Stars forward Colin Blackwell also played for the Rangers in 2020-21 and defenseman Nils Lundkvist was a Ranger during the 2021-22 season while Georgiev was with the Rangers.
