AT A GLANCE

EIGHT-DRIAN KEMPE

On Monday, Nov. 17, forward **Adrian Kempe** signed an eight-year contract extension with the Kings worth an average annual value (AAV) of \$10.625M that will keep the team's leading scorer in Los Angeles through the 2033-34 campaign. Kempe, 29, has a team-leading 19 points (6-13=19), two overtime goals and a plus-4 rating in 19 games played this season. The Kramfors, Sweden, native skates into SAP Center with five points (2-3=5) with a cumulative plus-4 rating in his last three games vs. San Jose, dating back to Nov. 25, 2024. In 34 career head-to-head contests against the Sharks, Kempe's 20 points (9-11=20) are the third most by a Kings skater against the Sharks among active roster players, following **Anze Kopitar** (28-47=75 in 98 GP) and **Drew Doughty** (8-33=41 in 77 GP).

ONE FINAL TRIP TO THE TANK

Captain **Anze Kopitar** is set to skate in his 50th and final career regular-season game at SAP Center in San Jose. It will also mark the captain's 99th matchup against the Sharks overall. Only **Shane Doan** has played in San Jose more (56 GP) and against the Sharks all-time (112 GP) than Kopitar. The captain has consistently found the scoresheet throughout his career against the Pacific Division rival Sharks with 75 points (28-47=75) in 98 career games against San Jose, including five points (1-4=5) in his last three outings. Kopitar's 75 career points vs. San Jose leads all active skaters and is tied for second-most in League history, while teammate **Corey Perry**'s 59 career points (31-28=59) places second among active skaters.

SWISS-SATIONAL

Forward **Kevin Fiala** skates into SAP Center after registering his team-leading fifth power play assist and seventh power play point (2-5=7) of the campaign on Monday night at Capital One Arena. Tomorrow night's contest will mark Fiala's 34th career game against the San Jose Sharks, having tallied 25 points (8-17=25) over his career, and 13 points (3-10=13) in 15 career games at SAP Center specifically. His 25 points are the third most among all skaters selected in the 2014 NHL Draft while teammate **Adrian Kempe**'s 20 points (9-11=20) are tied for fourth most.
