TEAM NOTES

- The Tampa Bay Lightning were defeated 4-2 by the Calgary Flames on Saturday night at Scotiabank Saddledome in Calgary.
- ✓ Tampa Bay slid to 14-13-5 overall and 6-10-2 on the road this season...The Lightning moved to 5-2-1 against Pacific Division opponents and 8-8-2 against Western Conference opponents.
- Tampa Bay finished its five-game road trip with a 2-3-0 record...The Bolts were outscored 12-0 in the second period over the course of the road trip.
- The Lightning outshot the Flames 33-26, including 17-6 advantage in the third period...The Lightning moved to 9-9-1 when outshooting their opponent.
- The Lightning moved to 6-4-0 over their last 10 games against the Flames and to 5-5-0 over their last 10 games at Calgary.
- The Flames snapped a four-game losing streak after going 0-2-2...Calgary won just its second game over its last eight contests.

PLAYER NOTES

- A.J. Greer, Mackenzie Weegar and Yegor Sharangovich each scored second period goals to give the Flames a 3-0 lead after two periods.
- Drayden Point scored his 14th goal of the season to cut Tampa Bay's deficit to 3-1 in the third period...Point scored his first NHL goal in his hometown of Calgary, Alberta...Point also notched an assist to record his 35th point of the season (14-21-35).
- Nikita Kucherov tallied two assists, his 51st and 52nd points of the season...Kucherov has recorded eight points over his last four games (3-5-8)...Kucherov recorded his 15th multi-point game of the season...Kucherov has found the scoresheet in seven of his last eight games against the Flames (3-12—15) with six multi-point efforts during that span...Kucherov paced the Bolts with six shots on goal.
- Steven Stamkos scored a power-play goal to bring the Lightning within one goal at 5:40 of the third period, the goal marked his 15th of the season (15-16—31) and his fifth goal over his last two games (5-0—5)...Stamkos' goal marked his 400th career power-play point two nights after he recorded his 200th career power-play goal...Stamkos has points in nine of his last 11 contests against Calgary (8-3-11) and has found he back of the net in each of the last three
- **Connor Zary** scored at 11:42 of the third period to extend Calgary's lead to 4-2.
- Andrei Vasilevskiy stopped 22 of the 26 shots he faced in defeat... Vasilevskiy's record moved to 5-5-0 this season.
- Nick Paul won 14 out of 19 draws, leading the Lightning in the faceoff circle and Calvin de Haan paced the Bolts with four blocked shots, a season-high for de Haan.
