TOP NOTES

The Sabres' win tonight gave them their first home winning streak of four or more games since they earned seven straight home wins from March 10 to April 8. 2025.

With his two goals in tonight's game, **Mattias Samuelsson** has now recorded at least one point in back-to-back games (2+1) and he has registered five points (3+2) in his last four matchups with the Maple Leafs.

Samuelsson's second goal marked the first time he had registered multiple goals in a single game.

Ryan McLeod's primary assist on **Samuelsson's** first goal gave him five points (2+3) in his last five games.

Alex Tuch's assist on **Samuelsson's** first goal extended his home point streak to five games and he has recorded seven points (3+4) in his last six games. His assist gave him the third-longest home point streak of his career. **Tuch** has recorded 17 points (8+9) in 14 games against the Maple Leafs as a member of the Sabres, including tonight's contest.

Tuch's shorthanded goal gave him two points (1+1) in tonight's game and it marked his sixth multi-point performance against Toronto in his career. He last registered multiple points against the Maple Leafs on Dec. 21, 2023 (0+4).

Owen Power recorded the primary assist on **Tuch's** goal and has notched four points (2+2) in his last four home games against Toronto.

Zach Benson and Tage Thompson each collected an assist on Jiri Kulich's goal. Benson's assist moved him into a tie for 11th place among all NHL skaters in assists this season (7).

In his last eight home games against Toronto including his two-point performance (1+1) tonight, **Thompson** has registered 10 points (4+6).

Kulich registered three points (1+2) in tonight's game, which matched his previous single-game career high. It marked the fifth multi-point effort of his career and the third time he has tallied at least one goal and one assist in a single game.

Bowen Byram's assist on **Thompson's** goal gave him one assist in back-to-back games.
