THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have earned at least one point in four consecutive games against the Maple Leafs (3-0-1).

If they earn at least one point in tonight's game, it will mark the first time since Nov. 15, 2014 to March 7, 2016 (4–0–1) that the Sabres have earned at least one point in five or more consecutive games against the Maple Leafs.

In his last eight games, **Alex Tuch** has tallied 11 points (2+9) and he is riding a seven-game point streak (1+9).

A point in tonight's game would mark the first time **Tuch** has registered a point streak of eight or more games as a member of the Sabres.

Tuch has tallied at least one assist in seven straight games, the longest assist streak of his career.



An assist in tonight's game would make **Tuch** the first Sabres skater since Jack Eichel from Nov. 19 to Dec. 2, 2019 (eight games) to record an assist streak of eight or more games.

Tage Thompson has recorded 14 points (8+6) in his last 10 games.

JJ Peterka has posted six points (5+1) in his last six games.

Peterka (22 years, 76 days) has recorded at least one goal in each of his last four games and a goal in tonight's game would make him the youngest Sabres skater since Donald Audette (22 years, 58 days) from Nov. 8 to 20, 1991 (five games) to record a goal streak of five or more games.

Peterka is the only Sabres skater who has recorded a goal streak of four or more games this season.

BACK-TO-BACK

Tonight's game concludes Buffalo's 12th and final back-to-back set of 2023-24, which opened with a 5-2 win against the New Jersey Devils last night.

The Sabres are 7-4-1 in the first game of back-to-back sets and 3-8-0 in the second game so far this season.

Buffalo's point breakdown in back-to-back sets this season is: four points (0), three points (0), two points (9), one point (1) and zero points (1).

ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 9-12-6 all-time on March 30.

<u>March 30, 2007:</u> Chris Drury records three points (2+1), including his careerbest 37th goal of the season, as the Sabres top the New York Islanders 6-4 in Buffalo.

March 30, 2011: Jhonas Enroth makes 23 saves to record his first career shutout in a 1-0 victory over the New York Rangers at home.

LEAF-ING NO DOUBT

Alex Tuch has registered 13 points (6+7) in his last seven games against Toronto, including at least two points in five of his last seven games against the Maple Leafs.

Jeff Skinner has notched 12 points (8+4) in his last 10 games against Toronto, including four points (3+1) in his last two home games against the Maple Leafs.

Dating back to the beginning of the 2021-22 season, **Tage Thompson** has 12 points (6+6) in 10 games against Toronto.

JJ Peterka has tallied five points (1+4) in his last four games against Toronto.

In his last four games against the Maple Leafs, **Owen Power** has recorded four points (1+3).
