AT A GLANCE

SWISS-SATIONAL

Thursday night's win against Washington saw forward **Kevin Fiala** (1-1=2) post his 13th multi-point effort of the season with his 25th goal and 19th assist of the campaign. With his power play marker in the third period, Fiala clinched his third career 25-goal season and bolstered his team-leading total of nine power play goals this year. The goal was Fiala's 53rd time finding twine on the man-advantage, breaking a tie with **Nino Niederreiter** for the third most power play goals all-time among skaters of Swiss nationality. Fiala has registered a point (3-1=4) in four of his five most recent matchups against the Nashville Predators. The winger has registered 11 points (7-4=11) in 16 career appearances against the club that selected him 11th overall in the 2014 NHL Draft.

WE ARE TRYING TO REACH YOU ABOUT YOUR EXTENDED WARREN-TY

Forward **Warren Foegele** skates into tonight's contest fresh of notching his 200th career NHL point (99-101=200) with his 19th goal of the season Thursday night. The opening marker of the Kings' clash with the Capitals stood as Foegele's team-leading sixth game-winning goal as Los Angeles secured the shutout against the highest-scoring team in the NHL. The native of Markham, Ontario, is the 30th skater from the 2014 NHL Draft to reach the 200-point mark, and only the second skater selected in the third round of that draft to accomplish the feat after Tampa Bay's **Brayden Point** (296-322=618).

HOME SWEET HOME

The Kings return to Crypto.com Arena for the final matchup of their three-game home-stand following the team's 3-0 shutout victory over the Washington Capitals on Thursday night. With the win, the Kings improved to 8-0-3 in their past 11 games on home ice, matching the third-longest home point streak in franchise history (also 11 GP in 2001-02 & 1990-91). The Kings skate into DTLA carrying their League-best .828 home points percentage (PTS %) along with 22 wins and 48 points.
