





- Became the first Ducks rookie goaltender with multiple 40-save appearances with 42 saves, Dec. 23 vs. CGY (also Dec. 17 @ EDM, 46).
- Stopped a career-high 46 shots, Dec. 17 @ EDM, the second-most saves made by a Ducks rookie goaltender in franchise history (Frederik Anderson, 49, Mar. 2 2014 vs. CAR).
- Earned his first win of the season and second of his career, stopping 23-of-25 shots, Dec. 15 @ MTL.
- Made a then career-high 35 saves in his season debut, Dec. 12 @ OTT...surpassed his prior mark of 33 set twice (last: Jan. 15, 2022 @ CHI).
- Also appeared in 34 games for Anaheim's primary AHL affiliate San Diego, earning an 11-21-0 record with a career-high three shutouts, 2.97 GAA and .912 SV%...
- Was named co-MVP of the 2023 AHL All-Star Challenge alongside Calgary Wranglers goaltender
 Dustin Wolf, Feb. 6,, the first duo to share the award since 2015 (Charles Hudon, Jacob Markstrom,
 West)...recorded two assists, tying Christopher Gibson (2018, Atlantic) for the most helpers in an
 All-Star Challenge/Game (since 1995)...became the third San Diego goaltender to participate in
 the AHL's midseason skills showcase, joining Kevin Boyle (2019, Springfield) and Anthony Stolarz
 (2020, Ontario).

2022-23 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- In his 13th season, set new career-highs in points (10-38-48) and assists, and matched his career-best playing in all 82 games (was one of two Anaheim skaters to appear in all 82 games).
- Led Anaheim defensemen in points, goals, assists and TOI/game (24:10)...his 48 points were the
 most by an Anaheim defenseman in a single season since Lubomir Visnovsky's 18-50=68 points
 in 2010-11 and tied for ninth most in franchise history.
- Skated in an NHL regular season record 38:54 TOI, Apr. 8 @ ARI...his TOI surpassed CGY's Dennis Wideman's 35:08 TOI, Jan. 18, 2014 @ VAN (TOI tracking began in 1997-98).
- Tallied a career-tying three assists (0-3=3), Mar. 12 vs. NSH...matched his prior best Feb. 15, 2016
 © CGY (0-3=3).
- Recorded his 400th career point, becoming the first defenseman and sixth skater in Ducks history to record 400 points (90-310-400), Feb. 25 @ CAR...joins Ryan Getzlaf (1,019), Teemu Selanne (988), Corey Perry (776), Paul Kariya (669) & Steve Rucchin (432).
- Earned two assists (0-2=2), his 65th career multi-point game, surpassing Scott Niedermayer (64) for sole possession of the most in franchise history by a defenseman, Feb. 17 vs. LAK.
- Earned a career-tying +4 rating three times: Apr. 1, 2022 @ ARI, Jan. 26 @ COL and Jan. 24 @ ARI.
- Recorded his 300th career assist, Jan. 13 vs. NJD, the fifth Duck to record 300 assists, joining Getzlaf (737), Selanne (531), Perry (404) & Kariya (369).
- Had multiple points in three straight games Nov. 15-19 (1-5=6), one of four defensemen in Ducks history with multiple points in three straight games, the first since Scott Niedermayer in 2008-09 (1-6=7).
- · Had a five-game point streak Nov. 15-23 (2-6=8), tying his career high set four prior times.

2022-23 **SEASON IN REVIEW**

THE 2022-23 SEASON: Anaheim completed the 2022-23 season with a 23-47-12 record for 58 points. Six players made their NHL debut during the campaign, including Pavol Regenda (Oct. 12 vs. SEA), Justin Kirkland (Dec. 20 @ LAK), Nikita Nesterenko (Mar. 21 vs. CGY), Olle Eriksson Ek (Apr. 8 @ ARI), Drew Helleson (Apr. 9 vs. COL) and Jackson LaCombe (Apr. 11 vs. VAN). Defenseman Cam Fowler and center Ryan Strome were the only Ducks to appear in all 82 games.

20-GOAL SCORERS: The Ducks had four skaters with 20-plus goals, including Troy Terry (23), Trevor Zegras (23), Adam Henrique (22) and Frank Vatrano (23). The four 20-goal scorers were the most the team has had in one season since 2015-16 when Corey Perry (34), Ryan Kesler (21), Rickard Rakell (20) and Jakob Silfverberg (20) each hit the milestone. Both Terry (23 in 2022-23 and 37 in 2021-22) and Zegras (23 in 2022-23 and 2021-22) have recorded back-to-back 20-goal campaigns for the Ducks, the first pair of Anaheim teammates to post consecutive 20-goal seasons since Ryan Kesler (three seasons from 2014-15 to 2016-17) and Jakob Silfverberg (two seasons from 2015-16 to 2016-17).

RECORD HOMESTAND: The Ducks hosted a franchise record 10-game homestand from Dec. 21 - Jan. 13 spanning 24 days). The homestand was tied for the third-longest in NHL history, trailing 12 straight at home by Tampa Bay (2010-11) and California (1975-76). The 24 days during the stretch were also the third most in league history, trailing Winnipeg (22 days, 2017-18) and Vancouver (22, 1981-82). Anaheim's longest prior homestand was eight games (three times), including Dec. 28, 2014-Jan. 16, 2015 (6-2-0, 12 pts.), Mar. 2-18, 2007 (6-1-1, 13 pts.) and Oct. 28-Nov. 14, 2001 (2-4-2, 6 pts.). The Ducks will also host an eight-game homestand Mar. 12-27, 2023. Below is a list of the longest homestands in NHL history:

GIBSON'S HISTORICAL FEATS: John Gibson's 1,783 saves were the most by any NHL goaltender in his first 53 games of a season since Gump Worsley stopped 1,893 shots for the NYR through 53 games in 1962-63 (60 seasons ago). Worsley (three times: aforementioned 1962-63, 1,854 in 1960-61 and 1,853 in 1955-56 all with NYR) and Jacques Plante (1,874 in 1963-64) are the only goaltenders to stop more shots through 53 games in NHL history. Among all-time NHL goalies with 10 appearances in a single season, Gibson set an NHL single-season record for most shots against per 60 minutes (39.6). Gibson became Anaheim's all-time franchise saves leader Mar. 10 @ CGY, with his 13th save and 11,814th of his career passing Guy Hebert (11,813). Gibson did so in his 423rd career appearance, 18 fewer than Hebert. He stopped 50-plus shots in three February games (53, Feb. 10 vs. PIT; 51, Feb. 20 @ FLA; 51, Feb. 25 @ CAR), becoming the second NHL goaltender since 1955-56 (since shots began being tracked) to register three outings with 50-plus saves in a single month (also Gump Worsely, Jan. 1963; three times). He is one of three goaltenders in NHL history with three outings of 50-plus saves in a single season (Worsley and Al Rollins (1955-56)). Gibson is now tied for second in NHL history with six career 50-save games, trailing only Gump Worsley (7).

GIBBY'S GAME: John Gibson ranked third among all NHL goalies in saves (1,783) and led the league in games with 50-plus saves (3). Gibson also had a league-leading five outings with 45-plus saves, while no NHL goaltender has more than three. Gibson also led the NHL in games with 40 saves (11) and 35-plus saves (24). Gibson set a franchise record with 53 saves while facing a club record 59 shots Feb. 10 vs. PIT, surpassing his prior high of 52 saves Apr. 12, 2022 @ FLA. Of Anaheim's 31 all-time games with 45-plus saves, Gibson has 13, seven more than Jonas Hiller's. Gibson co-led the NHL with two penalty shot saves (9-11 career saves) and continues to lead NHL goalies with seven penalty shots saved since 2020-21, four more than any other netminder. He set a single-season career high for saves (1,783) in his final outing, Apr. 13 vs. LAK. Set Anaheim's all-time record for saves with his 11,814th career save, Mar. 10 @ CGY, passing Guy Hebert (11,813).

CAM'S CAREER YEAR: Cam Fowler skated in an NHL record 38:55 TOI Apr. 8 @ ARI, surpassing the only other mark in NHL history above 38:00 by Dennis Wideman (38:05), Jan. 18, 2014 w/ CGY @ VAN (TOI began being tracked in 1997-98) and his prior personal high of 35:11 Jan. 9, 2022 vs DET. Fowler set a new single-season career high in points (10-38-48) and assists, and was one goal shy of matching his career output in 2016-17. He became the third defenseman in Anaheim history to reach 40 points three times (also 2021-22 and 2010-11), joining Scott Niedermayer (four times) and Chris Pronger (three times). Fowler led Anaheim blueliners in points (10-36-46), goals, PPG (4) and assists, while he was tied for second among team leaders in assists and third in points. He became the first defensemen and sixth skater in Anaheim Ducks history to record 400 career points (90-310-400), Feb. 25 @ CAR after earning his 300th career assist, Jan. 13 vs. NJD.

TERRY TIME: Troy Terry scored 20 goals for the second straight season (37 in 2021-22) and his point total of 23-38=61 saw him surpass 60 points in back-to-back seasons (67 in 2021-22). He led the Ducks in points per game (.87) and even-strength points (18-31=49), co-led in goals, and ranked second among in points and tied for second in assists. He completed the season on a six-game point streak (3-5=8), including his 100th career assist Apr. 11 vs. VAN to become the sixth-fastest player in franchise history to reach the milestone (273 GP), trailing only Paul Kariya (153 GP), Ryan Getzlaf (198 GP), Steve Rucchin (216 GP), Bobby Ryan (266 GP) and Andy McDonald (271 GP). He represented Anaheim at the 2023 NHL All-Star Weekend in Florida, his second straight appearance (also 2022 in Vegas). He is the fifth Anaheim forward to be named an All-Star multiple times (Paul Kariya, 7x; Teemu Selanne, 5x; Corey Perry, 4x; Ryan Getzlaf, 3x).

GENERATION 2: Trevor Zegras was the third-youngest NHL player (22 years) to lead his team in points, trailing only Ottawa's Tim Stutzle (20 years) and New Jersey's Jack Hughes (21 years). He set new single-season career highs in points, and assists, and matched his goal output from 2021-22. He led Anaheim in, points (23-42=65), assists, PPP (4-13=17), even-strength goals (19) and co-led in goals. He became the first Ducks player to record 40 assists in a season since Ryan Getzlaf (50 in 2017-18), while he and Terry were the first Ducks players to cross the 60-point mark in back-to-back seasons since Ryan Getzlaf (five times from 2013-14 to 2017-18). Zegras turned 22 this season, with his career 84 assists prior to age 22 the most by an Anaheim player in franchise history, while his 48-84=132 points in 169 GP marked the second-most points by an Anaheim player 21 or younger, trailing only Paul Kariya (68-79=147 in 129 GP). He is the second skater in franchise history to record multiple 60-point seasons before age 23, joining Kariya (50-58=108, 1995-96 & 44-55=99, 1996-97). He became the first player in franchise history to record multiple 20-goal seasons before age 22. With two assists Feb. 25 @ CAR, Zegras reached the 30-assist milestone for the second straight season, the first player in franchise history to record multiple 30-assist seasons at age 21 or younger (also 38 in 2021-22). Paul Kariya (58 in 1995-96), Ryan Getzlaf (33 in 2006-07) and Cam Fowler (30 in 2010-11) are the only other Ducks players to do so once.

QUE RICO!: Adam Henrique recorded the sixth 20-goal season of his career, his first campaign with 20 goals since 2018-19 (24). His goals surpassed his output from 2021-22 (19), while he reached 35 points for the 10th time in his 12 career seasons. Henrique completed te campaign tied for third among Ducks leaders in goals despite missed 19 games due to a sprained MCL suffered Feb. 21 @ TBL, where he co-led Anaheim with 19 goals at the time of his injury. Henrique recorded points in a career-tying seven straight contests Jan. 13-26 (6-3=9), matching his career-long point streak set over 10 years ago with New Jersey Nov. 25-Dec. 8, 2011 (2-7=9).

2022-23 **SEASON IN REVIEW**

TO BE FRANK: Frank Vatrano set a new single-season career-highs in points (22-19=41) and assists in his first season as a Duck. He surpassed his prior high set in 2018-19 (24-15=39) and his 2019-20 assist output (18), both with Florida. Vatrano ranked tied for third among Ducks leader in goals, his second campaign of 20-plus goals. Of his 22 goals in 2022-23, he scored a team-leading 15 on the road. Vatrano recorded the third hat trick of his career (first as a Duck) Jan. 26 @ COL, and first since Jan. 21, 2020 w/ FLA @ CHI (3-0=3). It was the lone hat trick by a Duck in 2022-23.

M(A)C ATTACK: Mason McTavish co-led all NHL rookies in PPG (7) and was third in scoring among league newcomers(16-26=42). He was also fifth in assists and tied for fifth in goals. Among Anaheim leaders, McTavish paced the club in PPG (7), was second in PPP (7-7=14) and PPA, fourth in points and assists, and fifth in goals. McTavish reached the 40-point mark with two goals Mar. 12 vs. NSH (16-24=40), passing Paul Kariya (18-21=39 in 1994-95) and Ryan Getzlaf (14-25=39 in 2005-06) for the sixth most points in a season by a Ducks rookie. He set a career-high three assists Feb. 27 vs. CHI (0-3=3) and a personal best +3 rating, tied for the second-most assists by a Ducks rookie in a single game (13th time). He recorded a career high 2-2=4 points Jan. 6 vs. SJS, the first Ducks player under age 20 to record four points in a single game since Stanislav Chistov (19 years, 176 days) Oct. 10, 2002 @ STL. His four points tied the Ducks franchise record for points by a rookie in a single game, joining Rickard Rakell (Jan. 11, 2015 vs. WPG, 2-2=4), Ryan Getzlaf (Mar. 24, 2006 vs. NSH, 0-4=4) and Stanislav Chistov (Oct. 10, 2002 @ STL, 1-3=4).

CLUTCH COMEBACKS: Anaheim recorded six multi-goal comeback wins, ranking fourth among NHL clubs behind only Chicago (7), New Jersey (8) and Vancouver (7). The Ducks also posted 12 comeback wins overall (six in the third period: three one-goal, three two-goal). The Ducks' three multi-goal comeback wins in the third period trailed only two teams with four: Los Angeles and the New York Islanders, Anaheim's six multi-goal comebacks ranked third in franchise history, trailing 2013-14 (9) and 2014-15 (8). Anaheim overcame a 3-0 deficit in the first period Jan. 19 @ CBJ to earn a 5-3 win, the fourth time in club history (11th overall) the Ducks have rallied from down three goals (or more) to win on the road (second regulation). The only other such road win in regulation came Dec. 2, 2018 @ WSH (trailed 5-1, won 6-5). Anaheim has recorded five third-period, multi-goal comeback wins in a single regular season twice: six in 2014-15, five in 2009-10 and 2013-14.
