## PLAYER NOTES

- **Matias Maccelli** opened the scoring for Toronto at 7:12 of the second period and scored his second goal of the game on a Maple Leafs power play opportunity at 8:13 of the third period, improving to 10 goals scored this season. Maccelli tied a single-game career-high in goals with two which he has marked on five occasions during his NHL career. Maccelli marked his fifth multi-point game of the season. Maccelli has scored in back-to-back games (3G).
- **Matthew Knies** scored for Toronto at 11:18 of the second period, posting his 14th goal of the season. Knies also recorded the secondary assist on Tavares' goal, posting his 32nd assist of the season. Knies marked his 14th multi-point game of the season.
- **John Tavares** scored the game-winning goal on a Maple Leafs power play opportunity at 7:42 of the third period, posting his 20th goal of the season. Per NHL Stats, "Tavares scored to record his seventh 20-goal season with the Maple Leafs and tied William Nylander, Mitch Marner and Rick Vaive for the seventh most in franchise history. It also marked his 16th career 20-goal campaign, which is tied for the 18th most in NHL history and the fourth most among active players."
- **Bobby McMann** capitalized on Edmonton's empty net at 17:22 of the third period, posting his 19th goal of the season. McMann has scored in back-to-back games (2G) and is currently on a three-game point streak where he has recorded three points (2G, 1A).
- **William Nylander** posted the primary assist on Tavares' goal, posting his 34th assist of the season. Nylander has recorded four points (1G, 3A) in his last two games and 16 points (7G, 9A) in his last nine games played.
- **Max Domi** posted the primary assist on Maccelli's second goal of the game, posting his 22nd assist of the season. Domi has recorded eight points (3G, 5A) in his last seven games.
- **Auston Matthews** posted the lone assist on McMann's goal, posting his 22nd assist of the season. Matthews has posted an assist in three-consecutive games (3A).
- **Anthony Stolarz** stopped 34 of 36 shots he faced in tonight's win.
- **Troy Stecher** was on the ice for a team-high 22 Toronto shot attempts-for at 5-on-5.
- **Jake McCabe** finished the game with a team-high 5-on-5 shot attempt percentage of 48.72 percent (19 for, 20 against).

## TEAM NOTES

- The Maple Leafs have earned a win in three-consecutive games.
- The Maple Leafs were 2-for-2 on the power play and 1-for-1 on the penalty kill tonight.
- Toronto has posted an 11-12-3 record on the road this season.
- The Maple Leafs have posted a 4-4-1 record in the second game of a back-to-back this season.
