AT A GLANCE

TAMING THE CATS

The Kings enter tomorrow's contest with victories in their last five consecutive contests against the Florida Panthers at Crypto.com Arena (5-0-0). The team has historically played very well when hosting the franchise from Sunrise, Fla., accumulating 18 wins in 24 contests for an all-time home record of 18-6-0 for a .750 points percentage (PTS %) which paces the League among teams to have hosted the Panthers at least 10 times. The Kings' special teams have been particularly successful against the Panthers, having converted on the power play in five of their last six meetings in DTLA. Overall, the team has scored 22 goals in 83 such opportunities for a power play percentage (PP%) of 26.5%, the highest by any team on home ice vs. Florida (min. GP: 10). The Kings carry a PP% of 21.7% in 44 games against Florida all-time, the third-highest rating against the Panthers among all active NHL clubs behind Minnesota (26.8%) and Toronto (21.2%).

8 MILE(STONE)

Defenseman **Drew Doughty** concludes the Kings' four-game homestand tomorrow night against the Florida Panthers as the Kings' all-time leader in goals scored by a defenseman. Doughty iced the Kings' 3-0 victory over the Winnipeg Jets on Tuesday, Nov. 4, with his 162nd career regular season goal. In doing so, the veteran blueliner broke a tie with **Rob Blake** (161 G), that had stood for exactly one week after Doughty scored his first goal of the campaign, the 161st of his career, on Tuesday, Oct. 28 in San Jose.

WE SURVEYED ONE HUNDRED

Forward **Quinton Byfield** (0-2=2) tallied his 13th career multi-assist game last Thursday night against Detroit. The pair of points marked Byfield's 98th and 99th career assists, while his set-up on **Kevin Fiala**'s power play goal on Tuesday night against Winnipeg punched Byfield's ticket to the century club. There have only been eight players to record 100 assists with the franchise before turning 24 years of age and only two in the last 30 years: **Anze Kopitar** (220A before 24 y.o.) and **Drew Doughty** (145A before 24 y.o.).
