- Thursday's game marked the first time this season that the Stars have been shut out. They are the last of all 32 NHL teams this season to be shut out.
- **Lian Bichsel** recorded seven hits, marking the 11th time this season in which he has recorded at least six hits in a single contest. **Bichsel** is now the first Stars skater to have at least six hits in 11 games in one season since Mark Fistric (16) did so in 2011-12.
 - **Bichsel's** seven hits also tie his career high that he has reached on two previous occasions. He is the only Stars skater this season to have seven hits in a game.
- **Mikko Rantanen** recorded three takeaways in tonight's game, which is tied for the most by a Stars skater in a single game this season.

GAME NOTES

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Tonight is the fourth and final game that the Stars will play against the Hockey Club this season and the second time they are playing in Dallas this year. The Stars have won their last three games vs. Utah: Earning a 2-1 win on Dec. 2, a 3-2 win on Dec. 23 and a 3-2 win on Jan. 4.
- The Stars enter tonight's game with a 50-23-6 record for 106 points and a .671 points percentage. Their 50 wins were tied for the second-most in the NHL and their point total and points percentage ranked third in the NHL this season entering play Friday.
- **Jamie Benn** enters tonight's game one goal shy of scoring his 400th career goal. When he reaches the milestone, he will become...
 - The second player in franchise history to score 400 goals, joining Mike Modano (557). 438 of Modano's 557 goals were scored with the Star after the team relocated to Dallas.
 - The second player drafted in 2007 to score 400 goals, with the other being Detroit's Patrick Kane (491).
 - The 10th active skater to score 400 career goals.
- Entering play Friday, the Stars ranked in the top five in the NHL this season in goals for per game (3.38, fourth) and in goals against per game (2.61, fourth).

PLAYOFF BOUND

- Dallas became the third team to clinch a berth to the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs with their 5-1 win over the Kraken in their game on March 29.

- 2024-25 season marks the 37th postseason appearance in franchise history and their fifth time in the past five seasons – tied for the most among all teams in that span according to NHL Stats.
- The Stars have made the Conference Finals in each of their past two postseasons and can become the fifth team in the past 20 years to do so in three straight (also TBL, CHI, LAK & DET) according to NHL Stats.
- The Stars have won nine series in the past 10 years, tied with the Penguins for the third most in the NHL in that span according to NHL Stats behind only the Lightning (18) and Golden Knights (11).

WHAT UTAH-KIN 'BOUT?

- Dallas is 3-0-0 all-time vs. Utah, including a 1-0-0 mark on home ice.
- The Stars are a perfect 5-for-5 on the penalty kill against the Hockey Club this season.
- **Jamie Benn** has recorded a point in each of Dallas' three games played against the Utah Hockey Club, tallying a goal in each of those performances.
- **Mikael Granlund** has registered a point in each of his three games played vs. Utah, earning five points (2-3–5) in those games, including putting up a three-point performance (1-2–3) on Oct. 28. His five points against the Hockey Club rank tied for the second-most in the league who have played Utah at least three times.
- **Mikko Rantanen** enters tonight's matchup having four points (1-3–4) in three games played against the Hockey Club.
- **Wyatt Johnston** enters tonight's contest riding a two-game point streak vs. Utah, earning three points (0-3–3) in those games, including putting up a multi-point effort (0-2–2) in Dallas' last game against the Hockey Club on Jan. 4.
- **Sam Steel** has registered two points (0-2–2) in his last three games vs. Utah.
- **Cody Ceci** enters tonight's contest riding a two-game point streak against the Hockey Club, totaling two points (0-2–2) during that span.
- If **Casey DeSmith** were to play and win tonight, he would become the second goaltender in the NHL to record three wins against the Utah Hockey Club. In his previous two games, he posted a 2-0-0 record with a .952 save percentage and a 1.51 goals-against average.
 - His save percentage is the best mark of any netminder to play the Hockey Club at least twice this season, while his goal against average is the second-best mark.

NOW YOU CECI ME, NOW YOU DON'T

- Dallas' last game on April 10 against Winnipeg was **Cody Ceci's** 82nd game played this season – he appeared in 54 regular-season games with the Sharks prior to being traded to Dallas, where he has played in 28 games with the Stars.
- If **Ceci** were to play in all three of Dallas' remaining games, he would become just the ninth player in NHL history to play in at least 85 games during a regular season, joining Tyson Barrie (2022-23), Rem Murray (2002-03), Bill Guerin (2000-01), Glenn Anderson (1993-94), Bob Kudelski (1993-94), Mark Lamb (1993-94), Joe Reekie (1993-94) and Jimmy Carson (1992-93).
- In 24 games since the Four Nations break (since Feb. 22), the Stars have outscored their opponents 29-14 at even strength when **Ceci** has been on the ice. His plus-15 on-ice even-strength goal differential was tied for the fourth-best mark in the NHL during that span entering play Friday.
- In all this season, **Ceci** has totaled 23 points (4-19–23) in 82 games, which makes the 2024-25 campaign the fifth-highest scoring season of his 12-year career.

I WANNA BE LIKE MIKE

- **Mikael Granlund** had a three-point outing (1-2–3) in Dallas' game on April 8 against Vancouver and now has 12 points (6-6–12) in his last 13 games played dating back to March 18.
 - **Granlund's** performance against the Canucks was his third three-point game of the season and his first as a member of the Stars.
- **Granlund's** six goals since March 18 are the most of any Stars skater during that span and his 12 points are tied for second on the team.
- Additionally, since March 18 the Stars have outscored their opponents 11-5 at even strength when **Granlund** has been on the ice. His plus-6 even-strength on-ice goal differential was tied for the third-best mark on Dallas' roster during that span, trailing only **Thomas Harley** (plus-10) and **Cody Ceci** (plus-7).
- **Granlund's** goal against the Canucks was his 22nd of the season, which is his second-highest total in a single season in his career, trailing only the 26 goals he scored with the Minnesota Wild in 2016-17.
- The 2024-25 season is already the third-highest scoring season of **Granlund's** 13-year career, and he enters tonight's game three points shy of matching his career high of 69 that he set in 2016-17.

BIKER GANG

- **Thomas Harley** has 27 points (9-18–27) in his last 29 games played dating back to Jan. 31, which is tied for fourth on Dallas' roster during that span.
 - **Harley's** 27 points (9-18–27) since Jan. 31 were the third-most during that span among all NHL defensemen entering play Friday, trailing only Colorado's Cale Makar (35) and Buffalo's Rasmus Dahlin (29).
- **Harley** tallied his 50th point of the season with an assist against the Canucks on April 8, making him the third Stars defenseman in the last 10 years to reach the 50-point plateau, joining **Miro Heiskanen** (2022-23 and 2023-24) and John Klingberg (2015-16 and 2017-18).

- **Harley's** assist also allowed him to tie Gary Sargen (71) for 25th-most assists by a defenseman in franchise history.
- **Harley** set a career high with his 16th goal of the season in Dallas' game on April 6 against the Wild. His 16 goals this year are tied for the sixth-most by a Stars defenseman in a single season in franchise history and were tied for the fifth-most among all NHL defensemen this year entering play Friday.
- **Harley's** assist against Pittsburgh on April 5 was his 33rd assist and 48th point of the season, both of which set career highs for the defenseman.
- Since Jan. 31 – Dallas' first game without **Miro Heiskanen** – **Harley** has been averaging 24:58 of ice time per game, which tops all Stars skaters and ranked ninth in the NHL entering play Friday.
 - Prior to Jan. 31, **Harley** was averaging 22:27 of ice time per game.
 - **Harley** skated a career-high 31:11 in Dallas' game on March 20 against the Tampa Bay Lightning. It was the highest time on ice total by a Stars skater in a regular-season game since **Heiskanen** skated 32:01 on April 11, 2021 against the Nashville Predators.
- When **Harley** has been on the ice during even-strength play this season, the Stars have outscored their opponents 93-58. His plus-35 on-ice even-strength goal differential was tied for the best mark in the NHL this season entering play Friday.
- **Harley** recorded the 100th point of his NHL career with an assist in Dallas' March 26 game against the Oilers, making him the third defenseman drafted in 2019 to reach the 100-point milestone, joining Detroit's Moritz Seider and Buffalo's Bowen Byram. He also became the 24th defenseman in franchise history to total 100 points with the Stars.
- **Harley's** 100th career point came in his 188th career regular-season games, making him the fourth-fastest defenseman in Stars/North Stars history to record 100 career points according to NHL Stats, following John Klingberg (145 GP), Craig Hartsburg (170 GP) and Brad Maxwell (170 GP).
- **Harley** matched his single-game career high with three points (1-2—3) in Dallas' March 18 game against the Ducks, surpassing Larry Murphy (93) for the 25th-most points by a defenseman in team history.
 - In that game, the Stars outshot the Ducks 15-2 when **Harley** was on the ice during 5-on-5 play according to Natural Stat Trick.
- **Harley's** game-winning goal in Dallas' March 22 game against the Flyers came just nine seconds into overtime, which set a record for the quickest overtime goal in franchise history according to NHL Stats.
- **Harley** is one of four defensemen this season to score two overtime goals. In total, he has scored five overtime goals since the start of 2023-24, which leads all NHL defensemen and is tied for fifth in the NHL.
- **Harley's** two-goal performance against the Flyers brought his season total up to 15, making him the third defenseman in franchise history to record consecutive 15-goal seasons according to NHL Stats, joining Phillippe Boucher (2 from 2005-06 – 2006-07) and Lou Nanne (1971-72 – 1972-73).

POWER UP

- Since Jan. 1, the Stars have gone 36-for-1119 on the power play for a 30.5 percent success rate, which was the fourth-best mark in the NHL during that span entering play Friday.
- The team's 36 power-play goals since Jan. 1 were tied with Detroit for the most in the NHL during that span entering play Friday.
- The Stars went a perfect 4-for-4 on the power play in their game on March 2 against the Blues, marking the first time that they have scored four power-play goals in a game since Nov. 12, 2023.
 - Dallas' game against St. Louis marked one of four instances this year in which a team has scored four power-play goals in a game. The Ottawa Senators (10/14 vs. LAK), Winnipeg Jets (10/18 vs. SJS) and Florida Panthers (12/5 at PHI) all previously did so.
- Their performance against the Blues also was the first time in Stars team history that the team had a 100 percent success rate on the power play in a single game while scoring at least four power-play goals.
- In all this season, the Stars have had three games in which they have scored at least three power-play goals – Oct. 24 at Boston (3), March 2 vs. St. Louis (4) and April 8 vs. Vancouver (3).

HOME COOKING

- The Stars have a 28-9-3 record at home this season. Entering play Friday, they ranked in the top five in the NHL in home wins (28, fourth), points (59, fourth) and points percentage (.738, tied fifth).
- Dallas is one home win shy of matching the franchise record of 29 set by the team in 1998-99.
- Since Jan. 24, the Stars have gone 17-for-45 on the power play at the American Airlines Center. Their 37.8 percent success rate on the power play at home was the second-best mark in the NHL during that span, and their 17 home power-play goals were also the second-most entering play Friday.
- **Jason Robertson** (42 points, 40 games played), **Mikko Rantanen** (42 points, 40 games played) and **Roope Hintz** (39 points, 38 games played) are all playing at a point-per-game pace at home this year.
 - **Robertson's** 42 home points this year are the most of any Stars skaters this season.
- **Matt Duchene** has tallied 22 points (5-17—22) in his last 20 home games.
- **Thomas Harley** has recorded 21 points (6-15—21) in his last 21 home games dating back to Dec. 31. His 21 home points during that span were tied for fourth and fifth, respectively, on the Stars and among all NHL defensemen entering play Friday.
 - Sixteen of those 21 points have come in the 13 home games that he has played since Feb. 2.

- He has 29 home points (8-21-29) in all this season, which was tied for 10th among NHL defensemen entering play Friday.
- **Mikael Granlund** has eight points (4-4-8) in his last eight home games, which includes posting a three-point performance (1-2-3) in Dallas' game on April 8 against the Vancouver Canucks.

THIRTY, FLIRTY AND THRIVING

- The Stars enter tonight's game with four players that have scored at least 30 goals this season: **Jason Robertson** (33), **Mikko Rantanen** (32), **Wyatt Johnston** (30) and **Matt Duchene** (30).
 - The 2024-25 campaign marks the first time the Stars' roster has housed four 30-goal scorers since the 1992-93 season when Russ Courtnall (36), Ulf Dahlen (35), Dave Gagner (33) and Mike Modano (33) all scored at least 30 goals.
- Entering play Friday, the Stars and the Tampa Bay Lightning were the only two teams this season to have four 30-goal scorers on its roster.
- Entering tonight's game, **Roope Hintz** is three goals shy of reaching the 30-goal mark. If he were to score 30 goals by the end of the regular season, it would mark the first time in franchise history that the Stars would have five 30-goals scorers on its roster.
- Additionally, the Stars could become the first team to have five 30-goal scorers on its roster since the Pittsburgh Penguins and Detroit Red Wings, who both did so during the 1992-93 season according to NHL Stats. Please note that this includes players who did not score all 30+ of their goals with one team.

DADDY ISSUES

- **Evgenii Dadonov** scored the second hat trick of his career with three goals against the Penguins in Dallas' April 5 game. **Dadonov's** first career hat trick also came against Pittsburgh on Feb. 24, 2018.
 - It made him the third Stars skater to score a hat trick this season, joining **Wyatt Johnston** and **Jason Robertson** who have each scored two hat tricks this year.
- **Dadonov's** third goal of the day was his 19th of the season, which makes 2024-25 the fifth-highest ranking season of his career in terms of goal scoring.
 - **Dadonov's** next goal will give him his fifth career 20-goal season.
- **Dadonov** is the sixth-oldest player this season to score at least 19 goals this year, joining Alex Ovechkin (42), Sidney Crosby (31), Anze Kopitar (20), Brad Marchand (22) and Patrick Kane (20).
- **Dadonov** enters tonight's game one point shy of recording the fifth 40-point season of his career.

SEEING STARS

- **Roope Hintz** was named the NHL's Second Star of the Week for the week ending on March 30 after tallying nine points (2-7-9) in four games played.
- It is the third time in his career that he has earned Star of the Week honors after previously being named the NHL's Third Star of the Week on April 12, 2021 and the Second Star of the Week on March 3, 2025.
- **Hintz** is one of 10 players this season to earn Star of the Week honors on multiple occasions.
- **Hintz** joins **Matt Duchene** (week ending on Oct. 27, 2024) and **Mason Marchment** (week ending on Nov. 17, 2024) as the three Dallas players to earn Star of the Week honors this season.
- **Hintz** has totaled 29 points (6-23-29) in 22 games played since the Four Nation Break. Since Feb. 22, his 23 assists were the third-most in the NHL entering play Friday and his 29 points were tied for sixth.
- According to Natural Stat Trick, when **Hintz** has been on the ice during 5-on-5 play since Feb. 22, the Stars have outscored their opponents 17-8.
- **Hintz** recorded his 200th career assist in Dallas' March 29 game against Seattle. With the assist he became...
 - The 28th skater in franchise history to total 200 assists with the team.
 - The 18th skater selected in the 2015 NHL Draft to reach the 200-assist milestone.
 - The 30th Finnish player in NHL history to have 200 career assists.
- In all this season, **Hintz** has totaled 65 points (28-37-65) in 73 regular-season games, making the 2024-25 campaign his fourth consecutive 60-point season.

IT TAKES TWO

- **Jake Oettinger** has an 20-7-3 record in his last 30 games played dating back to Dec. 29, posting a .915 save percentage and a 2.52 goals-against average during that span.
 - His 20 wins since Dec. 29 were the third-most in the NHL during that span entering play Friday.
- **Oettinger** made a season-high 41 saves in Dallas' March 26 game, a 4-3 win over the Oilers. The Stars were outshot 44-24 in that game.
- **Oettinger** made 33 saves for his 12th career shutout in Dallas' March 24 game, a 3-0 win over Minnesota, which tied Jon Casey for the sixth-most shutouts in franchise history.
 - **Oettinger** saved 5.74 goals above expected in the game according to MoneyPuck.com.
- **Oettinger's** shutout was also the 12th of his career, which tied teammate **Casey DeSmith** for the fifth-most by a U.S.-born goaltender in NHL history according to NHL Stats.

- The Stars' victory over the Wild was also the 146th win of **Oettinger's** career, which passed Cesare Maniago (145) for the fourth-most wins by a goaltender in franchise history.
- **Oettinger** earned his 30th win of the season in Dallas' game on March 6, a 3-2 overtime win over the Calgary Flames. According to NHL Stats, he became the fourth goaltender in Stars/North Stars history with four or more 30-win seasons, joining Marty Turco (6x), Ed Belfour (4x) and Kari Lehtonen (4x). He also joined Turco (6 from 2002-03 to 2008-09) and Belfour (4 from 1997-98 to 2000-01) as the only netminders to do so in four consecutive campaigns with the franchise.
- **Casey DeSmith** has posted an 8-1-1 record in his last nine games played dating back to Jan. 25 against the St. Louis Blues, posting a .926 save percentage and a 2.43 goals-against average in those contests.
- **DeSmith** made 46 saves in Dallas' March 27 game against the Flames, a 5-2 Stars win. His 46 saves were the most by a Dallas netminder this season and the third-most in a single game in **DeSmith's** career.
- In all this season, **DeSmith** has saved .61 goals above expected per 60, which was the eighth-best mark in the NHL this season entering play Friday among netminders that have played in more than five games.
- In all, **Oettinger** and **DeSmith** have combined for a .910 save percentage this season, which was the second-best mark of any team in the NHL this season entering play Friday. The duo's 2.59 goals-against average this season ranked fifth in the NHL this year entering play Friday.

CAREER YEARS ARE NEAR

- With three games remaining in the 2024-25 regular-season, several Stars players are withing striking distance of setting or matching various career highs.

KILLING IT

- The Stars have had an 83.9 percent success rate on the penalty kill this season, which was the second-best mark in the NHL this year entering play Friday, trailing only the Carolina Hurricanes (84.2 percent).
- Dallas has also allowed the fewest power-play goals against (35), and their -29 goal differential on the penalty kill this year was the third-best mark in the NHL entering play Friday.
- If the Stars maintain this pace, it would make the 2024-25 season their best on the penalty kill since 2007-08, when the team finished the season with an 85.6 percent success rate on the penalty kill.
- The Stars are also one of the least-penalized teams in the league, ranking 27th in the league in both total penalty minutes (550) and penalty minutes per game (6:57) entering play Friday.
- Entering play Friday, **Esa Lindell** was leading all NHL skaters in both total shorthanded ice time (284:35) and shorthanded ice time per game (3:36) this season.
 - **Lindell** had played 20 more minutes of shorthanded ice time than the second ranked player (Mike Matheson; 263:25) entering play Friday.

ONE FOR THE HISTORY BOOKS

- **Thomas Harley** is four goals shy of surpassing Barry Gibbs (35) for the 15th-most goals by a defenseman in franchise history.
- **Roope Hintz** is one goal shy of tying Danny Grant (176) for 15th-most goals in franchise history.
- **Esa Lindell** is two assists shy of tying Stephane Robidas (165) for 10th-most assists by a defenseman in franchise history.
- **Esa Lindell** is eight points shy of tying Lou Nanne (225) for 10th most points by a defenseman in franchise history.
- **Jason Robertson** is nine goals shy of tying Danny Grant (176) for 15th-most goals in franchise history.
- **Wyatt Johnston** is two goals shy of tying Radek Faksa (89) for 30th-most goals in team history.

- Stars goaltender **Casey DeSmith** and Utah forward Nick Bjugstad were teammates with the Pittsburgh Penguins in 2018-19 and 2019-20.
- Stars defenseman **Matt Dumba** and Utah forward Nick Bjugstad and defenseman Ian Cole were all teammates with the Minnesota Wild in 2020-21. Both Matt Dumba and Nick Bjugstad also played the following 2021-22 season together for the Wild.
- Stars forwards **Matt Duchene** and **Mikko Rantanen** and Utah forward Alex Kerfoot and defenseman Ian Cole all played for the Colorado Avalanche. Duchene played with Kerfoot in 2017-18. Rantanen and Kerfoot also played together in the 2018-19 season. Rantanen and Cole were members of the Avalanche from 2018-19 to 2020-21.
- Stars forward **Mason Marchment** and Utah forward Alex Kerfoot were both members of the Toronto Maple Leafs for a short time during the 2019-20 season.
- Stars forward **Colin Blackwell** and defenseman **Ilya Lyubushkin** were teammates with Utah forward Alex Kerfoot with the Toronto Maple Leafs for the 2021-22 season.
- Stars goaltender **Casey DeSmith** and Utah defenseman Ian Cole were teammates for a handful of games with Pittsburgh in 2017-18 and crossed paths again as members of the Vancouver Canucks in 2023-24.
- Stars goaltender **Casey DeSmith** and Utah defenseman Olli Matta were both members of the Pittsburgh Penguins for the 2017-18 and 2018-19 seasons.
- Stars defenseman **Brendan Smith** and Utah defenseman Ian Cole shared the ice in Carolina for the 2021-22 season.
- Stars forward **Matt Duchene** and Utah goaltender Connor Ingram were teammates for a short time in Nashville in 2021-22 where Ingram played three games.
- Stars forward **Colin Blackwell** and Utah goaltender Jaxson Stauber were both members of the Blackhawks during the 2022-23 season where Stauber played six games.
- Stars forward **Matt Duchene** and Utah assistant coach Mario Duhamel were both members of the Colorado Avalanche in 2013-14 to 2014-15 where Duhamel was a video coach.
