AT A GLANCE

DUCK DUCK JUICE

Forward **Adrian Kempe** kicks off the team's back-to-back riding a 10-game home point streak (3-12=15) against the Anaheim Ducks, dating back to April 26, 2021. In the teams' most recent matchup at Crypto.com Arena on Dec. 27, Kempe collected his then-18th helper of the year. His 10-game home point streak vs. Anaheim is the third-longest active home point streak against the Ducks, trailing **Nathan MacKinnon** (7-16=23 in 12 GP) and **Jack Eichel** (5-11=16 in 12 GP). Overall, only five players have established a home point streak exceeding 10 games versus Anaheim in League history. The other two: **Joe Sakic** (12 GP from Oct. 10, 1996 – Jan. 9, 2003) and **Henrik Zetterberg** (11 GP from March 15, 2006 – Nov. 5, 2011).

A BRANDT NEW YEAR

Defenseman **Brandt Clarke** enters Friday's contest with four points (1-3=4) in his last three games, including Wednesday night's game-tying tally with nearly 90 seconds remaining in regulation. Per NHL PR, it was the latest game-tying goal by a Kings defenseman since **Drew Doughty** on Oct. 28, 2023 vs. Vegas (58:57). Clarke began his three-game point streak with his then-15th and 16th assists of the season last Saturday at Rogers Place as part of his sixth multi-point game of the season. On Jan. 3 vs. Minnesota, Clarke scored the game-deciding shootout goal (GDG) in his first career shootout attempt to become just the second blueliner in team history to tally the game-decider in their first shootout attempt, joining **L'ubomir Visnovsky** on Feb. 18, 2007, in Anaheim.

AT THE DROP OF A HAT

In the last matchup against the Kings and Ducks on Dec. 27, forward **Alex Laferriere** scored his first career hat trick as part of his third career three-point game (3-0=3) and now has five goals (5-0=5) over his last three games vs. Anaheim, dating back to April 10, 2025. With his trio of goals, Laferriere not only became the first Kings skater to record a hat trick this season, but also the second different team skater to tally a hat trick against the intrastate rival Ducks, joining **Adrian Kempe** who has accomplished such feat twice (April 13, 2023 & March 8, 2021).
