TEAM NOTES

- ★ Columbus had its eight-game home points streak snapped following tonight's loss. The club went 5-0-3 at Nationwide Arena from Oct. 29-Dec. 4, tying for the second-longest in franchise history (7-0-1 from Oct. 21-Nov. 21, 2016; 8-0-0 from Nov. 29, 2016-Jan. 3, 2017; 8-0-0 from Feb. 24-Mar. 22, 2018).
- ★ The Blue Jackets have recorded points in 10 of the last 12 (8-2-2) and 11 of the past 14 (9-3-2) games played at Nationwide Arena.
- ★ The Jackets scored on their lone power play opportunity tonight against the Senators and have now scored a PPG in six-consecutive games at Nationwide Arena against the club (7-of-12, 58.3 pct.) and are 8-of-22 (36.4 pct.) in the last 11 games of the overall series.
- ★ CBJ have scored a power play goal in five of their past six games this season (6-of-17; 35.3 pct.).

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ RW **Yegor Chinakhov** (2-2-4, 24 GP) skated in his 200th career NHL game tonight and has tallied 36-39-75 since making his debut in 2021-22.
- ★ D **Dante Fabbro** (2-3-5, 31 GP) scored in the second period for his first goal since Oct. 29.

- ★ **C Adam Fantilli** (11-10-21, 31 GP) collected an assist on Jenner's goal and now has 2-2-4 in his last five games this season. He improved his career mark against Ottawa to 2-1-3 in five career outings with all points in his three games at Nationwide Arena.
- ★ **C Boone Jenner** (4-8-12, 17 GP), who returned to action after missing the last 14 games with an upper body injury suffered on Nov. 11 at Seattle, collected his fourth multi-point effort of the season with a goal and assist. His assist was the 192nd of his NHL career (203-192-395, 758 GP), tying Nick Foligno for the fourth-most in franchise history. Jenner has now tallied 10-5-15 in 27 career games against Ottawa, including 6-3-9 in his last 11 overall and has 4-1-5 in four of his past five at Nationwide Arena after tonight.
- ★ **LW Kent Johnson** (3-4-7, 30 GP) notched an assist and now has 1-5-6 in 10 career games against the Senators, with 0-3-3 in back-to-back outings and 1-4-5 in five games played at Nationwide Arena.
- ★ **RW Kirill Marchenko** (10-16-26, 27 GP) assisted on Voronkov's power play goal for points in four of his past five overall (2-2-4). His helper gives him points in each of his last seven games at Nationwide Arena (1-7-8) as well as in 10-of-11 games played at home this season (3-8-11).
- ★ **LW Dmitri Voronkov** (12-10-22, 31 GP) scored on the power play for the second consecutive game and has goals in three of his past four this season (3-1-4). His goal gives him 4-0-4 in seven career matchups against Ottawa with tallies in back-to-back matchups and now has 3-0-3 in his four career games at Nationwide Arena.
- ★ **D Zach Werenski** (9-23-32, 31 GP) collected his 11th multi-point (5th multi-assist) effort of the season with 0-2-2. He has now collected points in nine consecutive home games dating back to Oct. 29 (5-11-16), tied for the fifth-longest home points streak in club history. The blueliner skated in his 598th career game tonight, surpassing David Savard for the most among defensemen in franchise history. He has 4-17-21 with six multi-point efforts in 20 career matchups against the Senators, including assists in 10 of his last 11 games overall (0-14-14) and stretched his home points streak against the club to eight games (2-9-11).
