WASHINGTON CAPITALS PRESEASON NOTES

HOME SWEET HOME – The Capitals host the Detroit Red Wings on Thursday for their second of six preseason games. Washington fell to the Buffalo Sabres 4-3 in the shootout in Sunday's preseason opener at Capital One Arena. Nicolas Aube-Kubel, Ryan Hofer and Sonny Milano scored for the Capitals, while Milano scored Washington's lone shootout goal. The Capitals' all-time preseason record is 172-131-33-19. Since 2011-12, the Capitals are 21-6-7 at home in preseason games.

GR8 – Alex Ovechkin is expected to make his preseason debut on Thursday versus Detroit. With 822 career goals, Ovechkin needs 73 goals to pass Wayne Gretzky (894g) for first on the NHL's all-time goals list. Ovechkin, who is signed with the Capitals for the next three seasons, would need to average 25 goals per season during that span to supplant Gretzky as the NHL's all-time leading goal scorer. Ovechkin has scored 25 or more goals in 17 of his 18 NHL seasons, with the shortened 2020-21 campaign (24g in 45 GP) being the only season in which he did not reach the 25-goal mark. With a 30-goal season in 2023-24, Ovechkin would pass former Capital Mike Gartner (17) for the most 30-goal seasons in NHL history. Ovechkin also enters the season 15 points shy of 1,500 career points, 53 games shy of 1,400 career games and one power-play goal shy of 300 career power-play goals.

HERE'S JOHNNY – John Carlson is expected to make his preseason debut on Thursday versus Detroit. Carlson enters the season 73 games shy of 1,000 career games and could become the third player in franchise history to play 1,000 games with the Capitals, joining Alex Ovechkin (1,347 GP) and Nicklas Backstrom (1,097 GP). Carlson averaged 0.73 points-per-game in 2022-23 (9g-20a-29p in 40 GP), the third-highest rate on the team (minimum 20 GP). Since 2017-18, Carlson ranks second in the NHL in points among defensemen (79g-278a-357p in 401 GP) and first in points per game (0.89) (minimum 400 GP). Carlson missed 42 games last season, including 36 consecutive games from Dec. 27 to March 21 after taking a shot to the face on Dec. 23 versus Winnipeg. The Capitals went 14-18-4 (.444 point percentage) in Carlson's absence after a 19-13-4 (.583 point percentage) start to the season.

WHIP IT – Tom Wilson, who signed a seven-year, \$45.5 million contract extension with the Capitals in August, is expected to make his preseason debut on Thursday. Wilson recorded 22 points (13g, 9a) in 33 games (0.67 P/GP) with the Capitals last season, a 54-point pace over 82 games. Despite missing 49 games in 2022-23, Wilson ranked tied for fifth on the team in goals and power-play goals (4).

OSH BABE – T.J. Oshie returns for his ninth season with the Capitals, needing 42 more games to reach the 1,000-game mark. Oshie recorded 18 points (9g, 9a) in his final 21 games (0.86 P/GP) of the 2022-23 season, including 16 points (8g, 8a) during a 14-game stretch (1.14 P/GP) from Feb. 14 – March 15. Oshie's 10 multi-point games last season tied for the third most on the Capitals (Alex Ovechkin: 19; Dylan Strome: 17; Evgeny Kuznetsov: 10).

YOUNG GUNS – 2022 first-round pick Ivan Miroshnichenko (20th overall) and 2023 second-round pick Andrew Cristall (40th overall) are expected to make their Capitals preseason debuts on Thursday versus Detroit. Miroshnichenko recorded four points (3g, 1a) in 23 games with Avangard Omsk in the Kontinental Hockey League (KHL) last season, where he averaged 8:27 of ice time per game. Miroshnichenko also recorded three assists in four games with Omskie Krylia in the Supreme Hockey League (Russia-2) and 14 points (10g, 4a) in 12 games with Omskie Yastreby in the Junior Hockey League (Russia-Jr.) in 2022-23. Miroshnichenko tallied seven points (2g, 5a) in 16 playoffs games with Omskie Yastreby, which ranked tied for eighth on the team. Cristall, 18, spent the 2022-23 season with the Kelowna Rockets of the Western Hockey League (WHL), leading the team in goals (39), assists (56) and points (95). Cristall's 1.76 points-per-game rate ranked fourth in the WHL, while his 95 points ranked tied for sixth. Cristall was named Kelowna's team MVP and was selected to the WHL B.C. Division First All-Star Team. The Vancouver, British Columbia native won a gold medal with Canada at the 2022 Hlinka Gretzky Cup, finishing the tournament with six points (1g, 5a) in five games. In addition, Cristall served as an alternate captain at the 2023 Under-18 World Championship, where he registered six points (2g, 4a) in seven games and helped Canada to the bronze medal.

HARDY PARTY – Hardy Häman Aktell, who signed a one-year, two-way entry-level contract with the Capitals on April 27, is expected to make his preseason debut on Thursday versus Detroit. Häman Aktell, 25, recorded 36 points (9g, 27a) in 51 games with the Växjö Lakers of the Swedish Hockey League (SHL) last season. The 6'3", 220-pound defenseman led Växjö in plus/minus (+23), ranked second on the team in assists and points and tied for third among SHL defenseman in points. The Kåge, Sweden native added seven points (3g, 4a) and recorded a +6 plus/minus rating in 18 playoff games, helping Växjö capture the SHL championship for the second time in three years. Häman Aktell was originally drafted by the Nashville Predators in the fourth round (108th overall) of the 2016 NHL Draft.

HOME GROWN – In total, 12 players selected by Washington in the NHL Draft are on the roster for Thursday's preseason game, including 2016 first-round pick Lucas Johansen. Johansen, 25, recorded seven points (1g, 6a) in 40 regular-season games with Hershey and added six points (2g, 4a) in 20 playoff games during the Bears' run to the Calder Cup championship. Johansen ranked tied for first on Hershey in plus/minus rating (+6) and ranked second among Bears' defensemen in points during the playoffs. Johansen has played three NHL games with the Capitals, including two during the 2022-23 season.

MODEL OF CONSISTENCY – The Capitals enter 2023-24 looking to make the playoffs for the ninth time in the last 10 seasons and the 33rd time in franchise history. The Capitals have reached the postseason in 14 of the last 16 seasons, joining the Pittsburgh Penguins (15) and the Boston Bruins (14) as the only teams with as many appearances in the last 16 years.
