MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ The Blue Jackets have won six of their last eight overall matchups against Toronto since Dec. 14, 2023 (6-2-0).
- ★ Columbus has scored five-plus goals in five of the victories over the stretch, as well as six or more in four of them.
- ★ The Blue Jackets have won three-straight meetings at Nationwide Arena, scoring six goals in each victory.
- ★ Seven of the last 12 games in the series have seen the winning team score five goals or more.
- ★ The Jackets have killed off all 11 Leafs power play chances in the last five contests.
- ★ The winning team has won by three or more goals in five of the last seven meetings.
- ★ The teams have combined for six or more goals in 11 of the last 15 games of the series, including nine instances with seven-plus goals.
- ★ C Cole Sillinger has tallied points in three-straight home games against the Leafs (3-2-5) after posting 2-1-3 on Oct. 29.
- ★ D Zach Werenski has collected points in nine of his last 11 games vs. Toronto (1-14-15) after posting 1-1-2 in Oct. 29 meeting and 0-3-3 at Toronto on Nov. 20.



JACKET TO WATCH - C Adam Fantilli

Has 6-2-8 in 8 career GP against the Maple Leafs, including two three-point efforts after notching 2-1-3 at Toronto on Nov. 20.

Has 1-1-2 in 4 career home outings against the club.





LEAF TO WATCH - C John Tavares

Has 21-24-45 with 13 multi-point efforts in 40 career GP against Columbus. Has points in six of his last seven games overall vs. the club (4-4-8).



TEAM NOTES

- ★ CBJ failed to earn a point for just the second time in the last nine games (4-2-3) in a 5-1 loss at Washington on Monday.
- ★ The Jackets have played in eight one-goal games (4-1-3) in their past 10 overall, with six decided after regulation. CBJ have seen 12 of their last 16 contests dating back to Oct. 25 (7-2-3), as well as 15 of the 23 contests in 2025-26 (65.2 pct.), decided by a single goal.
- ★ The club, which plays three of its next four games at Nationwide Arena, closed out a stretch of nine-of-12 games played on the road from Nov. 2-24 at Washington on Monday.
- ★ Columbus blueliners lead the NHL in goal percentage scored by defensemen (25.8) and rank second in goals scored in 2025-26 with 17-31-48 in 23 contests.
- * CBJ are in a stretch of 13-of-14 games played against the Eastern Conference from Nov. 15-Dec. 11.

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ C Charlie Coyle, who leads the club in scoring at home this season (2-8-10, 9 GP), sits one point shy from 500 for his NHL career (192-307-499, 973 GP).
- ★ C Adam Fantilli has tallied goals in six of the past nine games (7-2-9) and has points in seven of the last 10 (7-4-11).
- ★ G Jet Greaves has earned points in his past seven consecutive starts (4-0-3) since Nov. 10.
- ★ D Denton Mateychuk has recorded points in consecutive games (1-1-2) and ranks second among club blueliners in goals and points with 5-4-9 in 22 contests in 2025-26.
- ★ D Zach Werenski had his season-high six-game points streak (3-7-10) snapped at Washington. The Grosse Pointe, Michigan native ranks second in the NHL in TOI/GP as well as leads league blueliners in shots on goal and ranks third in goals (tied), points (tied) and multi-point efforts with 7-14-21, 7 multi-point GP, 89 shots and 26:26 TOI in 23 contests.
