CAPTAIN CROSBY

Sidney Crosby recorded his third multi-point game of the season on Tuesday against Minnesota [3A] to tie Joe Sakic for the eighth-most multi-point games in NHL history (473).

- Crosby, who sits at 473 multi-point games in his career, already leads all active players in multi-point outings.

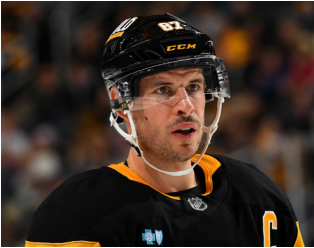

MALK-A-MANIA

Evgeni Malkin has 15 points (7G-8A) in his last nine games against the Anaheim Ducks, which includes five multi-point efforts.

- In 23 career games against the Ducks, Malkin has tallied 11 goals, 18 assists and 29 points. Among all active players (min. 15 GP), Malkin's 1.26 goals-against average against Anaheim is the fourth highest:

SLICKY RICKY

Rickard Rakell recorded his first multi-goal game of the season on Tuesday night against Minnesota, and first since Feb. 27, 2024, to extend his team-leading goal total to six on the season.

- Rakell ranks first on the Penguins in goals and third on the team in points (8), behind only Evgeni Malkin (14) and Sidney Crosby (10). His team-leading goal total also ranks 10th in the NHL this season.
- Rakell's six goals and eight points through his first 11 games of the season are the most he has had in that span to open a season in his career:

- Rakell spent parts of the first 10 seasons of his career with the Ducks from 2012-22, tallying 154 goals, 185 assists and 339 points in 550 games.
- He ranks in the top-10 on Anaheim's all-time records lists in goals (6th), assists (9th), points (8th), even-strength goals (121, 5th), power-play goals (33, 9th) and game-winning goals (27, 5th):
