TOP NOTES

As a result of their two power-play goals today, the Sabres have recorded five such goals in their last two games. It marks the most power-play goals by Buffalo in any two-game span since Dec. 4 to 7, 2022 (five).

Buffalo killed all seven of its penalties in today's game. It marked the first time since Nov. 30, 2022 at Detroit (seven penalties killed) that the Sabres have killed seven or more penalties without allowing a single power-play goal.

Alex Lyon's shutout marked the fifth of his career and his first since Oct. 22, 2024 at NY Islanders as a member of the Detroit Red Wings. His 32 saves were the most he had ever posted in a shutout in his career.

With his two-goal performance, Josh Doan has now registered five points (2+3) in his last two games. His first tally marked his first goal as a member of the Sabres.

Rasmus Dahlin recorded an assist on Doan's first goal. In his last seven games against Florida including today, he has posted seven points (2+5). Dahlin's assist gives him a three-game assist streak, the 30th assist streak of three or more games in his career.

Tage Thompson notched an assist on Doan's first goal and has registered one point in three consecutive home games against the Panthers (1+2) and his assist gave him a three-game point streak (1+3).

Doan's second goal marked the second multi-goal performance of his career and his first since March 26, 2024 (2+0) vs. Columbus as a member of the Arizona Coyotes.

Zach Benson registered an assist on Doan's second goal and now has five assists in his last two games. He joined Pat LaFontaine (1992-93; five assists) as the only players in Sabres history to record five or more assists in their first two games of a season.

Jason Zucker assisted on Buffalo's second goal and he is now riding a four-game point streak (1+3) against the Panthers. He became the first Sabres forward since Sam Reinhart from Feb. 1, 2018 to Feb. 19, 2019 (seven games; 4+6) to register a point streak of four or more games against the Panthers.

Owen Power's goal marked the 20th goal of his career and his first since March 17, 2025 at Boston. Alex Tuch registered the primary assist on the goal and he has seven points (3+4) in his last seven home matchups against Florida.
