Tage Thompson has registered nine points (6+3) in his last eight games.

Jack Quinn has registered five points (3+2) in his last four games.

Buffalo ranks second among

The Sabres have allowed the fewest power-play goals against (8) among all NHL teams and rank first among all NHL teams in power-play goals allowed per game played (0.33).

BACK-TO-BACK

Tonight's game concludes Buffalo's third of 13 back-to-back sets in 2025-26, which opened with a 5-0 loss last night vs. the Devils.

The Sabres are 1-2-0 in the first game of back-to-back sets and 0-1-1 in the second game so far this season.

Buffalo's point breakdown in back-to-back sets this season is: four points (0), three points (1), two points (0), one point (0) and zero points (1).

ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 14-13-1 all-time on November 29.

November 29, 1981: Lindy Ruff records his first career hat trick in a 5-2 win at home against the New York Islanders.

November 29, 1993: Dominik Hasek picks up his first shutout as a member of the Sabres, stopping all 24 Toronto shots in a 3-0 win.

November 29, 1998: A two-goal night from Michael Peca leads the Sabres to a 6-3 victory over the Lightning in Tampa.

INTO THE WILD

Buffalo has earned at least one point in six of its last eight games against Minnesota (5-2-1).

The Sabres have earned at least one point in four of their last five road contests against the Wild (3-1-1).

Rasmus Dahlin has recorded eight points (2+6) in his last seven games against Minnesota.

Dahlin has 11 points (4+7) in 11 career games against the Wild, the most points by a Sabres defenseman against Minnesota in franchise history. Jake McCabe ranks second with five points (1+4).

Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen has recorded a 3-2-1 record, a .922 save percentage and a 2.44 goals-against average in six career games against the Wild.

Luukkonen's .922 save percentage is the highest mark by a Sabres goaltender against Minnesota in franchise history (min. 2 games played).

In four road games in Minnesota in his career, **Luukkonen** is 2-1-1 with a .924 save percentage and a 2.18 goals-against average.

Alex Lyon has earned a win in the only two games he has played against Minnesota in his career.

In those games, he has posted a .943 save percentage and a 2.00 goals-against average.
