TOP NOTES

With his goal, **Jason Zucker** has now posted eight points (3+5) in his last seven games. **Zucker** has recorded seven points (3+4) in six games since returning from an illness on Nov. 21.

Bowen Byram's goal gave him six points (2+4) in six career home games vs. Winnipeg. **Byram's** five goals are tied with **Mattias Samuelsson** for the most goals by a Sabres defenseman this season.

Jack Quinn tallied the primary assist on **Byram's** goal. **Quinn** has registered six points (3+3) in his last six games, including four points (2+2) in his last four games in Buffalo.

Josh Norris' first goal gave him two points (1+1) on the night. It marked the first time he had registered at least one goal and one assist in the first period of a game since he did so on Dec. 23, 2023 vs. Pittsburgh as a member of the Ottawa Senators (1+1).

With his primary assist on **Norris'** first goal, **Tage Thompson** has registered 10 points (6+4) in his last 10 games. **Thompson** has tallied six points (4+2) in his last six home contests.

As a result of his goal, **Alex Tuch** has posted six points (2+4) in his last four home games. He leads all Sabres skaters in points (23).

Josh Doan's assist on **Tuch's** goal gave him two assists in tonight's game. It marked his second multi-assist game this season (0+3 on Oct. 15 vs. Ottawa) and the fourth multi-assist performance of his career.

Doan's primary assist on **Zucker's** goal and two assists in total gave him at least one point in back-to-back games (1+2). It marked the second time **Doan** has registered at least one point in two or more consecutive games (three games; Oct. 28 to Nov. 1; 2+1) this season.

Norris' second goal marked his third point (2+1) in tonight's contest. With the goal, he matched his single-game career high in points. It marked the sixth time he had recorded three points in a game in his career and the first since Jan. 30, 2025 vs. Washington.

Zach Benson posted two assists in tonight's game. It marked the second time this season, and the ninth time in his career, that he had collected multiple assists in a single game.
