## AT A GLANCE

### JUICY JANUARY

Forward **Adrian Kempe** skates into Edmonton as the Kings' outright leader in assists (19) and points (15-19=34) this year. Tonight's meeting will be Kempe's first regular-season contest against the Oilers since he recorded his 15th career three-point outing in the Kings' 5-0 victory on April 14, 2025, at Rogers Place. In that game, Kempe contributed two power play assists, his 36th and 37th helpers of the year, before burying his 34th goal of the campaign in the final frame to clinch his second consecutive 70-point season (35-38=73 in 2024-25; 28-47=75 in 2023-24). In 31 career regular-season contests against the Pacific Division rival Oilers, Kempe has 18 points (8-10=18), including a pair of game-winning tallies.

### CAN'T CATCH 22

Forward **Kevin Fiala** returns to Rogers Place for the first time in the regular season since posting a multi-point night (1-1=2) in the Kings' 5-0 victory in the building on April 14, 2025. That contest saw the winger pot his co-team-leading 35th goal (**Adrian Kempe**: 35 G) of the 2024-25 season and marked his second consecutive regular-season contest with a goal against the Oilers, joining his game-winning tally from April 5, 2025, in downtown Los Angeles. In total, Fiala has scored the game-winning goal three times against the Edmonton Oilers in the regular season as part of his 11 tallies and 15 points (11-4=15) in 21 career appearances.

### WITHOUT A DOUGHT

Defenseman **Drew Doughty** returns to Rogers Place tonight for a matchup with his soon-to-be-teammate at the upcoming 2026 Winter Olympic Games in Milan Cortina, Richmond Hill, Ontario, native **Connor McDavid**. In 61 all-time regular-season games played against the Edmonton Oilers, Doughty has notched 43 points (13-30=43), trailing only **Brent Burns** (17-37=54 in 83 GP) for the most by an active defenseman, while his +24 rating is the highest among all current blueliners against the Alberta-based franchise. Of note, Burns has also spent time at forward while playing for Minnesota and San Jose.
