TOP NOTES

James Reimer made 33 saves in tonight's game and registered his first shutout since Feb. 17, 2024 at Calgary (38 saves) as a member of the Detroit Red Wings. It marks the first shutout by a Sabres goaltender since **Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen** made 35 saves on 35 shots on Jan. 9 at Ottawa.

Reimer's current seven-game winning streak is tied with Roger Crozier and Tom Barrasso for the seventh-longest winning streak by a goaltender in Sabres history. He is two wins away from moving into a tie with Gerry Desjardins (Dec. 11 to 29, 1976; nine consecutive wins) for the longest such streak in franchise history.

Tage Thompson's goal gave him a five-game goal streak, which is the longest goal streak of his career. **Thompson** has posted 46 points (28+18) in his last 42 games, including 11 points (10+1) in his last eight games.

Thompson's goal moved him into sole possession of first place among all NHL skaters in even-strength goals (37).

Alex Tuch's goal gave him six shorthanded goals on the season, the most among all NHL skaters. In his last nine games, **Tuch** has posted 13 points (8+5), including at least one point in seven straight games.

Tuch's six shorthanded goals are tied with Michael Peca (1996-97) for the third-most all-time by a Sabres skater in a single season. Only Don Luce (eight in 1974-75) and Craig Ramsay (seven in 1974-75) have registered more shorthanded goals in a season with Buffalo.

Including his assist on **Tuch's** goal, **Ryan McLeod** has posted 18 points (5+13) in his last 17 games. **McLeod** has registered seven points (4+3) in his last five games against Carolina, including at least one point in each of the games in that span.

McLeod's assist made him the first Buffalo skater to register five or more points (3+2) in their first three games against Carolina as a member of the Sabres since Doug Gilmour tallied five points (1+4) from March 27 to Oct. 25, 2000.
