TEAM NOTES

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP

● The Maple Leafs are scheduled to take on the Nashville Predators tonight at Scotiabank Arena in the first of two games between the clubs this season. Toronto posted a 1-0-1 record against Nashville during the 2023-24 season while posting a 6-3-1 record through their last 10 meetings. The Maple Leafs are skating in their second matchup of a three-game homestand (1-0-0). Toronto has posted an 11-3-0 record at Scotiabank Arena this season, currently leading the league in wins on home ice with 11. The Maple Leafs have captured a win in six of their last seven games while earning a point in 10 of their last 12 games (9-2-1).

LAST GAME

● The Maple Leafs won 4-1 against the Chicago Blackhawks on Monday night at Scotiabank Arena. John Tavares scored the game-winning goal for the Maple Leafs at 11:59 of the second period. Auston Matthews, Fraser Minten and Matthew Knies (EN) also scored a goal each in Toronto's win. William Nylander posted the primary assist on Matthews' goal, recording his 11th assist of the season. With the 322nd assist of his NHL career, Nylander claimed sole possession of 11th on the franchise all-time list for most assists, passing Doug Gilmour. Mitch Marner (2A) marked his seventh multi-assist game of the season and his 13th multi-point game of the season, nine of which have been recorded in his last 11 games played. Anthony Stolarz stopped 27 of 28 shots he faced in Toronto's win.
