- The Stars will hold practice at 11:30 a.m. CT at Comerica Center on Saturday, March 23.

NOTES

- Captain **Jamie Benn** (2-0—2) recorded his first multi-goal performance of the season with two goals in a span of 1:18 in the second period. Benn's goals gave him points in 12 of his past 15 games (6-11—17). It marked Benn's 46th career multi-goal game and moved him within one of tying **Bill Goldsworthy** (47 w/ MNS) for fifth place on the franchise's all-time list.
- Forward **Joe Pavelski** (1-0—1) recorded his 12th season with at least 25 goals, the third most among U.S.-born players behind only **Keith Tkachuk** (13x) and **Mike Modano** (13x). The 39-year-old ranks third on the Stars in goals (25) and has 59 points (25-34—59) in 71 GP this season.
- Forward **Jason Robertson** (0-2—2) recorded his second consecutive multi-point performance with two assists against Pittsburgh. Robertson, who leads the club in assists (48) and points (24-48—72), has points in 10 of his past 11 games (5-10—15).
- Defenseman **Thomas Harley** (0-1—1) extended his point streak to four consecutive games (1-4—5) with an assist vs. the Pens. Harley continues to pace Stars blueliners in goals (15) and ranks second in assists (25) and points (15-25—40) in 68 GP this season.
- With an assist, forward **Logan Stankoven** (0-1—1) pushed his point streak to three consecutive games (1-2—3), his second point streak of three games this season (13 GP). Stankoven has 11 points (6-5—11) over that span.
- Forward **Sam Steel** (1-0—1) scored his eighth goal of the season at the 4:37 mark of the third period. Steel is two goals shy of tying his career high (10 in 65 GP w/ MIN in 2022-23).
- Forward **Craig Smith** (0-1—1) recorded an assist to give him points in four consecutive games (3-1—4). Smith has 17 points (10-7—17) in 65 GP this season.
