## MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ Columbus has earned points in five of the last seven meetings dating back to Dec. 9, 2022 (4-2-1).
- ★ The home team has won seven of the past eight matchups and eight of the past 10 games in the series.
- ★ The Jackets have outscored the Flames 11-4 during a three-game home win streak in the series.
- ★ The winning team has won by three or more goals in four-straight meetings and multiple goals in eight of the past nine since Jan. 26, 2022.
- ★ The winning team has scored four or more goals in six of the past nine contests in the series.
- ★ The winning team has allowed two goals or less in five-straight at Nationwide Arena and nine of the past 10 in Ohio, including four shutouts.
- ★ The Jackets have scored on 30.8 percent of their power play chances over the last six contests (4-of-13).



### JACKET TO WATCH - RW Kirill Marchenko

Has collected 3-2-5 in seven career GP vs. Calgary. Has 2-2-4 in his last three contests, including 2-1-3 in the most recent meeting at Nationwide Arena on Nov. 29, 2024.



### FLAME TO WATCH - LW Blake Coleman

Has 8-7-15 and two multi-point efforts in 29 GP vs. Columbus. Has collected points in his last four straight games (2-2-4) and has totaled 5-6-11 in his past 12 contests.



## TEAM NOTES

- ★ Columbus wrapped up a four-game road trip with a 3-2 OT victory at Utah on Sunday. The club returns home to play seven of the next eight contests at Nationwide Arena from Jan. 13-28.
- ★ The Jackets have scored the first goal in 10 of the last 14 contests and 13 of the past 19. The team ranks sixth-T in the NHL in games scoring first in 2025-26 (25).
- ★ Columbus leads the NHL in goals by defensemen and ranks fourth in points with 34-79-113 in 45 contests.
- ★ The Blue Jackets rank third in the league in faceoff percentage since Dec. 13 (53.5 pct. in 14 GP).
- ★ CBJ have denied opponents on 30-of-34 power play chances over the last 11 games and rank third-T in the NHL in penalty kill pct. since Dec. 20 (88.2).

## PLAYER NOTES

- ★ **G Jet Greaves** stopped 25-of-27 shots in the win at Utah and leads the NHL in saves (251) and ranks second-T in wins and seventh in save percentage since Dec. 22 (min. 5 GP) with a 5-3-1 record, 2.57 GAA and .916 SV% in nine contests.
- ★ **C Boone Jenner**, the club's all-time leader in games played, is two assists from becoming the fourth Blue Jacket to record 200 career assists (206-198-404, 772 GP).
- ★ **RW Kirill Marchenko** collected two assists at Utah and has notched points in eight of the last 10 contests (6-5-11).
- ★ **D Ivan Provorov**, who has assists in four of the last six games, collected his 300th career point at Utah on Sunday (82-218-300, 741 GP). He ranks fourth in the NHL in TOI/GP in 2025-26 (25:55).
- ★ **LW Dmitri Voronkov** notched his team-leading 7th power play goal with the OT winner at Utah. He has collected 3-1-4 in the last six games and has points in seven of the past 11 contests (4-3-7).
- ★ **D Zach Werenski** has registered points in 21 of his past 25 contests overall to lead NHL blueliners in goals, points and points-per-game and rank second-T in assists since Nov. 13 (12-24-36, 1.44). He has also posted points in each of his past 14 games at NWA, ranking fourth among all NHL skaters in scoring at home since Oct. 29 (10-16-26, 10 multi-point efforts).
