LETTERS AND NUMBERS

Captain **Anze Kopitar** gears up for his 29th and final career home game against the Blackhawks, which will break a tie with former Kings captain Dustin Brown (28 GP) for the most home games against the Original Six organization in LA Kings franchise history. Additionally, defenseman and assistant captain **Drew Doughty** prepares for his 24th such game, which will break a three-way tie with two other former Kings' lettermen, **Luc Robitaille** (23 GP) and **Dave Taylor** (23 GP) for sole possession of third on that list. With 42 career points (16-26=42) in 58 career games played against the Central Division foe, Kopitar will have a final opportunity to break a tie with **Butch Goring** (15-27=42) for third most points against Chicago in Kings history behind Dave Taylor (20-23=43) and **Marcel Dionne** (21-37=58) when he takes the ice tomorrow.


CALIFORNIA DREAMIN'

Thousand Oaks, Calif., native **Trevor Moore** (1-0=1) scored his fourth goal of the season on Thursday night, extending his home point streak against the Chicago Blackhawks to a seventh straight game (4-4=8), dating back to March 24, 2022. Moore became the fourth player in LA Kings franchise history to record a home point streak of at least that length against Chicago, joining **Butch Goring** (5-11=16 in 8 GP), **Bernie Nicholls** (9-8=17 in 10 GP) and **Marcel Dionne** (6-14=20 in 11 GP). Moore also became the first undrafted skater in franchise history to record a seven-game home point streak against the Blackhawks and is the only active undrafted skater across the League to have achieved such a streak. He is the first undrafted skater to do so since **Wayne Gretzky**'s 17-game home point streak against Chicago (11-34=45) from Nov. 26, 1980, through Feb. 1, 1992. Gretzky's streak began in Edmonton (12 GP) and ended in Los Angeles (5 GP)

LAF-ING TO THE BANK (CASHING CHECKS)

Forward **Alex Laferriere** recorded eight hits in Thursday's meeting with the Blackhawks, tying a single-game career-high he set earlier this season, Oct. 8, in Las Vegas. Since his rookie season in 2023-24, Laferriere's 306 hits are the most by any Kings skater; 69 of those hits have been recorded in 2025-26, the most on the team and the fourth-highest number of hits logged by any skater in the 2021 NHL Draft class this season.
