## TEAM NOTES

- ★ The Blue Jackets earned their second-straight win to kick off a five-games in eight-day stretch.
- ★ CBJ and the Islanders have split the first two games of the season series with each team winning their home game in regulation.
- ★ The Jackets improved to 7-4-2 in back-to-back sets this season, including 4-1-2 in the first game.
- ★ Columbus posted its third, third-period comeback win of the season tonight after trailing 2-1 heading into the final frame.
- ★ The Blue Jackets scored the first goal for the 20<sup>th</sup> time overall this season (12-4-4) and the 11<sup>th</sup> time at Nationwide Arena (7-3-1).
- ★ Columbus skated in front of its fourth sellout crowd of the season tonight (others: 11/28 vs. PIT; 11/13 vs. EDM; 10/13 vs. NJD).

## PLAYER NOTES

- ★ **C Adam Fantilli** (12-12-24, 37 GP) tallied an assist for the second-straight game. He improved to 4-3-7 in eight career matchups against the New York Islanders and stretched his points streak against the club to four games (2-2-4).

- ★ **G Jet Greaves** (10-9-5, 24 GP) posted 24 saves tonight (.923 SV%) to improve his career record against the Islanders to 2-1-0 with 1.33 GAA and a .954 save percentage in three career starts.
- ★ **RW Kirill Marchenko** (13-16-29, 33 GP) notched his third multi-goal – and fourth multi-point effort – of the season with two tallies tonight and has goals in back-to-back games (3-0-3). The multi-goal performance was the 12<sup>th</sup> of his career, tying his for the seventh-most in franchise history (Sanderson & Werenski). He improved to 4-4-8 in 10 career games against the Islanders with points in five-straight meetings (3-3-6) and has 3-2-5 in five career home games.
- ★ **LW Mason Marchment** (7-10-17, 32 GP) notched an assist to extend his points streak to three games since joining the Blue Jackets on Dec. 19 (3-1-4). He became the fourth player in the last 10 years to record a point in their first three games as a Blue Jacket (Others: Luca Del Bel Belluz; 3 GP in 2023-24 to 2024-25, Stefan Matteau; 3 GP in 2019-20 and Zach Werenski; 4 GP in 2016-17).
- ★ **D Denton Mateychuk** (6-10-16, 36 GP) collected his first multi-point/assist game of the season tonight with two helpers to extend his assist streak to three games (0-4-4).
- ★ **C Sean Monahan** (5-14-19, 37 GP) tallied two assists tonight for his third multi-point and second multi-assist performance of the season. He improved his career mark against the Islanders to 6-14-20 with five multi-point efforts in 22 career matchups, with assists in the last four meetings (0-6-6) and 2-12-14 in his last 13 games overall against the club.
- ★ **D Ivan Provorov** (5-9-14, 37 GP) scored to tie the game at 2-2 in the third period and has 1-1-2 in his last three games played.
- ★ **C Cole Sillinger** (4-12-16, 36 GP) scored on an empty net for his fourth of the season and first since Dec. 6 to improve to 4-3-7 in 14 career games vs. NYI, with 2-3-5 in his last six games.
- ★ **D Damon Severson** (2-11-13, 37 GP) collected a helper on Marchenko's second goal and extended his assist streak to three games (0-4-4).
