PLAYER NOTES

- **Max Pacioretty** scored on a Maple Leafs power play opportunity at 18:19 of the first period, posting his second goal of the postseason. Per NHL Stats, “Pacioretty scored his 27th career playoff goal which tied Matthew Tkachuk, Brock Nelson and Brandon Saad for the third most among active American players (min. 1 GP in 2024-25).” Pacioretty also recorded the primary assist on Nylander’s goal, posting his fourth assist of the postseason. Pacioretty marked the 13th multi-point game of his playoff career (1G, 1A). Pacioretty is currently on a three-game point streak where he has recorded six points (2G, 4A).
- **William Nylander** scored for Toronto at 4:18 of the second period, posting his sixth goal of the postseason which is “the most in a playoff year by a Maple Leafs player since Joe Nieuwendyk (6 in 2004),” per NHL Stats. Nylander has scored five goals in his last three games, totalling seven points during his goal streak (5G, 2A).
- **Max Domi** scored for the Maple Leafs at 17:09 of the second period, posting his second goal of the postseason. Domi also registered the secondary assist on Pacioretty’s goal, posting his second assist of the postseason. Domi marked the seventh multi-point game of his playoff career (1G, 1A).
- **Mitch Marner** scored the game-winning goal for Toronto at 5:50 of the third period, posting his second goal of the postseason. Marner has recorded a point in three-consecutive games (1G, 2A).
- **Morgan Rielly** posted the primary assist on Pacioretty’s goal and the secondary assist on Domi’s goal, improving to three assists recorded during the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs. Rielly marked the seventh multi-assist game of his playoff career and the seventh multi-point game of his playoff career. Per NHL Stats, “Rielly recorded his seventh career multi-assist playoff game and passed Dave Ellett (6) for the second most by a Maple Leafs defenseman. Only Borje Salming has more with nine.” With two points tonight, Rielly improved to 46 career playoff points, claiming sole possession of second on the franchise’s all-time list for playoff points among defencemen, passing Ian Turnbull (45). Rielly has posted three points in his last two games (1G, 2A).
- **Oliver Ekman-Larsson** recorded the secondary assist on Nylander’s goal, posting his second assist of the postseason. Ekman-Larsson has recorded an assist in back-to-back games.
- **Steven Lorentz** registered the primary assist on Domi’s goal, recording his first assist of the postseason and first postseason point as a Maple Leaf.
- **Jake McCabe** recorded the primary assist on Marner’s goal, posting his fourth assist of the postseason. McCabe has registered three assists in his last two games.
- **Auston Matthews** registered the secondary assist on Marner’s goal, recording his sixth assist of the postseason.
- **Joseph Woll** stopped 25 of 28 shots he faced in tonight’s win.
- **Brandon Carlo** was on the ice for a team-high 15 Toronto shot attempts-for at 5-on-5.
- **Bobby McMann** (6 for, 4 against) and **Pontus Holmberg** (9 for, 6 against) finished the game with a team-high 5-on-5 shot attempt percentage of 60.00 percent.

TEAM NOTES

- The Maple Leafs were 1-for-3 on the power play and 1-for-2 on the penalty kill tonight.
- The team registered 41 hits during tonight's matchup, a single-game second-best during the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs. **Max Pacioretty** led the team in hits tonight with seven while **Scott Laughton** ranked second on the team with five.
- Per NHL Stats, "The last time the franchise had multiple 2-0 series leads in the same postseason was 1963 (SF vs MTL & SCF vs DET)."
