#### **PLAYER NOTES**

- Scott Laughton scored for the Maple Leafs at 8:39 of the third period, posting his fourth goal of the season.
- Morgan Rielly recorded the lone assist on Laughton's goal, posting his 19th assist of the season.
- Auston Matthews won 15 face-off attempts tonight going 79% (15 won, 4 lost), tying a single-game high this season. The Maple Leafs currently lead the league in face-off percentage this season, improving to 57% after tonight's game.
- **Dennis Hildeby** stopped 17 of 21 shots he faced in tonight's loss.
- Oliver Ekman-Larsson was on the ice for a team-high 18 Toronto shot attempts-for at 5-on-5.
- **John Tavares** and **William Nylander** finished the game with a team-high 5-on-5 shot attempt percentage of 77.27 percent (17 for, 5 against).

#### **TEAM NOTES**

- The Maple Leafs were 0-for-4 on the power play and 3-for-3 on the penalty kill tonight.
- Toronto has posted a 5-10-0 record on the road this season.
- The Maple Leafs have posted a 3-3-0 record in the second game of a back-to-back this season.
- At 8:27 of the second period, Toronto initiated a coach's challenge to determine whether Dallas's goal was off-side. Per the NHL's Situation Room, "Video review determined that Dallas' Roope Hintz preceded the puck into the offensive zone and was in an off-side position prior to Mavrik Bourque's goal. According to Rule 38.9, "The standard for overturning the call in the event of a "GOAL" call on the ice is that the NHL Situation Room, after reviewing any and all available replays and consulting with the On-Ice Official(s), determines that one or more Players on the attacking team preceded the puck into the attacking zone prior to the goal being scored and that, as a result, the play should have been stopped for an "Off-Side" infraction; where this standard is met, the goal will be disallowed." Result: Call on the ice is overturned No Goal Dallas
