AT A GLANCE

KING OF KINGS

Captain **Anze Kopitar** (1-1=2) scored his 303rd even-strength goal (EVG) last night in San Jose and will tie **Dave Taylor** (304 EVG) for the third most in Kings franchise history with his next such tally. Only **Luc Robitaille** (344 EVG) and **Marcel Dionne** (369 EVG) have scored more at even-strength in an LA uniform. Kopitar's performance last night at SAP Center was also his 320th career multi-point game; he will tie Robitaille (321) for the second most in team history with his next such performance. The Slovenian centerman skates into tonight's contest with 21 points (8-13=21) in 29 career contests against the Boston Bruins, including a goal on his lone shot of the game in the two sides' last meeting on March 23, 2025, at Crypto.com Arena.

CRIMSON PRIDE

Former Harvard University forward **Alex Laferriere** looks to continue his productive start to the month of November tonight when the Kings host the Boston Bruins. Since his rookie season in 2023-24, the 24-year-old has earned three points (2-1=3) in four career matchups against the New England-based franchise, including both of his previous occasions (1-1=2) hosting the Bruins in DTLA, dating back to Oct. 21, 2023. On the defensive side of the puck, Laferriere has recorded 288 hits since his debut on Oct. 11, 2023, the most hits among all Kings skaters in that span. Through the Kings' first 21 games this year, his 51 hits are the most on the team, while his 13 blocked shots (BkS) trail only **Trevor Moore** (15 BkS) and captain **Anze Kopitar** (18 BkS) for the most among Kings forwards.

BYFIELD BACK HOME

Forward **Quinton Byfield** takes the ice tonight in downtown Los Angeles carrying a three-game point streak (1-3=4) against the Boston Bruins, dating back to Feb. 17, 2024. The 23-year-old center returns to Southern California tied with **Adrian Kempe** (13 A) for the most assists by a Kings skater after recording his 13th helper of the season this past Saturday in Ottawa. In doing so, the Canadian forward extended his point streak to a third game (2-3=5), dating back to Nov. 11 in Montreal, before being held off the scoresheet on Monday in Washington.
