THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have earned a win in each of their last two games against the Golden Knights, outscoring Vegas $8\mathchar`-4$ in those games.

Each of Buffalo's last seven games have been decided by one goal.

If tonight's game is decided by one goal, the Sabres will match the franchise record for the most consecutive games decided by one goal.

In Buffalo's last 18 games, **Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen** has made 16 starts and has recorded 401 saves on 430 shots (.933) in that span.

Luukkonen ranks fourth in shutouts (4), seventh in goals-against average (2.46) and 10th in save percentage (.914) this season.

Rasmus Dahlin has registered at least one point in back-to-back games (1+2) and a point in tonight's game would give **Dahlin** his sixth point streak of three or more games this season.

Tage Thompson has recorded one goal in each of his last two games and a goal in tonight's game would give him his first goal streak of three or more games this season.



Thompson has totaled five goal streaks of three or more games in his career, all of which came with Buffalo.

Alex Tuch has recorded one point in each of his last two games (1+1).

Tuch would earn his fifth point streak of three or more games in 2023-24 with a point in tonight's game.

BACK-TO-BACK

Tonight's game opens Buffalo's ninth of 12 back-to-back sets in 2023-24, which concludes with a home contest against the Winnipeg Jets tomorrow night.

The Sabres are 4-4-0 in the first game of back-to-back sets and 3-5-0 in the second game so far this season.

Buffalo's point breakdown in back-to-back sets this season is: four points (0), three points (0), two points (7), one point (0) and zero points (1).

<u>March 2, 2007:</u> The Sabres score eight goals, including the first two of Mike Ryan's career, to top the Montreal Canadiens 8-5 and improve to first place in the NHL.

Alex Tuch has recorded five points (3+2) in five games against the Golden Knights in his career, including at least one point in each of his last two games against Vegas.

In five games against Vegas in his career, **Dylan Cozens** has notched six points (1+5), including a three-point performance (1+2) in the last matchup between the Sabres and Golden Knights.

In his only start against the Golden Knights in his career on Dec. 19, 2022, **Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen** recorded 41 saves on 43 shots (.953).
