ON THE ROAD AGAIN

The Penguins continue their Western Canada road trip tonight in Edmonton with a matchup against the Oilers at 9:00 PM ET at Rogers Place.

- Through four road games this season, Lars Eller leads the way with four goals, while Kevin Hayes and Rickard Rakell both rank second on the team with three tallies away from PPG Paints Arena.
- Eller's four goals on the road are the most in the league, while Hayes and Rakell are just one tally shy of the most among all players:

Sidney Crosby, who has two multi-point games through eight outings this season, sits one multi-point night away from tying Joe Sakic for the eighth-most instances in NHL history.

- Crosby, who sits at 472 multi-point games in his career, already leads all active players in multi-point outings.

RAKIN' UP THE POINTS

Rickard Rakell scored his fourth goal of the season on Tuesday night in Calgary to tie Lars Eller for the team lead.

- Over Rakell's last six games, the forward has tallied four goals and five points, ranking first in goals and third in points on the Penguins in that span.
- Rakell's four goals through his first eight games of the season tie the most he has had in that span to open a season in his career, while his five points are the second most he has had in the same season-opening span:

HOW SWEDE IT IS

Penguins defenseman Erik Karlsson has put up points against the Edmonton Oilers throughout his career.

- Karlsson has tallied six goals, 21 assists and 27 points with a plus-11 against the Oilers in 27 career games.
- Karlsson averages 1.00 points per game against Edmonton in his career, which is one of seven teams that he averages at least one point per game against.
- His 1.00 points-per-game average is the highest among all active defensemen:

- Karlsson has six points (1G-5A) through the first eight games of the 2024-25 season, which ranks third on the Penguins. His five assists and six points this season are each the 10th most among defensemen in the NHL this year.
