### AT A GLANCE

#### BROTHERLY LOVE(RTIME)

The LA Kings return to the City of Brotherly Love with points in 12 of their last 13 games against the Flyers (10-1-2) at Xfinity Mobile Arena dating back to the 2010-11 season. The team's .846 points percentage (PTS %) in Philadelphia during that span paces all teams in the League (min. GP: 10). Of those 13 games, seven have gone past regulation with LA taking five of the seven contests. Since both franchises joined the NHL in the 1967 expansion, the Kings are 7-4-2 vs. Philadelphia in overtime and 3-0 in shootouts. Six of their seven extra-time wins against the Flyers overall, and two of their three shootout victories, have come at Xfinity Mobile Arena. Out of the last 13 games played in the venue between these two teams, nine have been decided by one goal with seven going past regulation.

#### HOW SWEDE IT IS

Forward **Adrian Kempe** skates into Philadelphia on a five-game point streak (3-2=5), dating back to Saturday, Jan. 17, in Anaheim. This is Kempe's 11th career point streak of at least five games in length and second such streak this season (3-7-10 in 7 GP from Oct. 18 – Oct. 30, 2025). Should he record a point tomorrow at Xfinity Mobile Arena, the 29-year-old will secure his sixth-ever point streak of at least six games in length, tied for the fourth longest streak of his career behind a nine-game run (6-7=13) from Oct. 24 – Nov. 11, 2023. Kempe skates into tomorrow's matinee with eight goals and 11 points (8-3=11) and a pair of game-winning goals through 14 career head-to-heads with the Philadelphia Flyers.

#### BRAVO, BRANDT!

Defenseman **Brandt Clarke** notched his 20th assist of the season on Thursday night at KeyBank Center, accounting for the 22-year-old blueliner's seventh point (1-6=7) of the campaign earned on the man-advantage. The Kings' leader in offense from the defense this season, Clarke (6-20=26) is tied with **Corey Perry** (11-15=26) for fourth-most points and tied with **Kevin Fiala** (20 A) for second most assists among all Kings skaters behind **Adrian Kempe** (23 A). He looks to add to those totals tomorrow in Philadelphia, having already earned a pair of assists (0-2=2) and a +2 rating in two career games played against the Flyers.
