KINGS NOTES

- Captain **Anze Kopitar** (1-0=1) scored his first goal of the season and the 441st of his career tonight at Crypto.com Arena. The center's goal was the 125th of his career to be scored on the man-advantage, tying **David Pastrnak** and teammate **Corey Perry** for the eighth most among active players.
- The tally marked Kopitar's 449th career power play point (125-324=449), putting him one shy of joining **Marcel Dionne** (172-298=461) as the only skaters in franchise history to record 450 power play points.
- Kopitar's goal tonight stands as the ninth of his career against the Florida Panthers, tying former Kings captain **Dustin Brown** (9G) for the most against the Atlantic Division club in Kings history.
- Forward **Adrian Kempe** (0-1=1) extended his team lead in assists with his 11th helper of the campaign.
- Forward **Quinton Byfield** (0-1=1) picked up his 10th assist of the season, securing his fourth consecutive season reaching double-digit assists. Only Anze Kopitar and **Drew Doughty** (5x each) have recorded more 10-assist seasons with the Kings before turning 24 years old. Byfield now sits one helper shy (101A) of tying **Rob Blake** (102A) for the eighth most assists by a Kings skater before the age of 24.
- Forward Corey Perry (1-0=1) scored his sixth goal of the season while playing in his 700th career home game; the 40-year-old is now tied with Kempe and Kevin Fiala for the most goals among all Kings skaters through the first 15 games of the 2025-26 campaign.
- Defenseman **Joel Edmundson** (0-1=1) collected his sixth assist of the season, tying Anze Kopitar for third on the team in the category behind Byfield (10 A) and Kempe (11 A).
- Defenseman **Mikey Anderson** (0-1=1) recorded his third point of the season with his second assist in as many games (0-1=1; Nov. 4 vs. WPG).
- Per NHL PR, with Anze Kopitar, Corey Perry and **Brad Marchand** each scoring, tonight's contest marks only the third time in the past 20 years that three players age 37 or older each scored in the same game. The only other instances involved **Shane Doan**, **Marian Hossa** and **Michal Rozsival** on Feb. 4, 2016 with the Coyotes and Blackhawks as well as **Jaromir Jagr**, **Bryce Salvador** and **Patrik Elias** on March 14, 2014 with the Devils and Panthers.
