Signed by the Rangers as a free agent on July 1, 2025, Vladislav Gavrikov skated in a career-high 82 games for the Los Angeles Kings and recorded 30 points (5G, 25A) in 2024-25. Among Kings skaters, he ranked first in blocked shots (140), second in plus/minus (+26) and second in time on ice per game (23:05), and among NHL defensemen, he ranked third in shorthanded time on ice (269:44) and 12th in plus/minus in 2024-25. The Yaroslavl, Russia native won a gold medal with the Olympic Athletes from Russia team at the 2018 Winter Olympics.
