PRACTICE UPDATE:

- The Stars will practice at 12 p.m. CT on Tuesday, Nov. 21 at **Children's Health StarCenter Farmers Branch** (12700 N Stemmons Fwy, Farmers Branch, TX 75234).

NOTES:

- Trailing 2-0, the Stars scored six unanswered goals in a 6-3 victory over the New York Rangers on Monday.
- Five of those goals were scored in the third period. The Stars have only scored more goals in the final frame once since relocating to Dallas: Feb. 6, 2009 (6 in the third period vs. NYR).
- Forward **Tyler Seguin** (1-1—2) scored the game-winning goal and moved within one of becoming just the third player in franchise history with 50. Seguin has goals in three consecutive games (4-2—6) and has multiple points in each of his past four contests (4-4—8).
- Forward Matt Duchene (6-9—15 in 16 GP) has points in each of his past six games and became the sixth player to register his first 15 career points with the Dallas Stars in 16 contests or fewer. Tyler Seguin (14 GP in 2013-14), Benoit Hogue (14 GP in 1995-96), Brett Hull (15 GP in 1998-99), Jason Spezza (16 GP in 2014-15) and Alex Chiasson (16 GP from 2012-13 2013-14) are the only ones to do so to date.
- Captain **Jamie Benn** tallied his fourth goal of the season in the second period vs. New York. Benn has points in two consecutive games (1-1—2) and four points over his past four games (1-3—4).
- Forward **Joe Pavelski** extended his point streak to four consecutive games with a multi-point effort (1-1—2) against the Rangers. Pavelski, 39, continues to pace the Stars in goals (8) and points (8-9—17) in 17 GP.
- Forward **Mason Marchment** (1-1—2) notched multiple points for the second game in a row. Through 17 GP, Marchment has four goals and 10 points (4-6—10).
- Forward **Roope Hintz** tallied his ninth career shorthanded goal with an empty-netter in the final frame. Hintz finished the game with three points (1-2—3), his second three-point game of the season (also Nov. 2 at EDM; 2-1—3).
- Forward **Sam Steel** (1-0—1) recorded his first goal with the Stars, which also served as his third career shorthanded marker.
- Goaltender **Scott Wedgewood** improved his record this season to 4-1-0 following a 30-save effort against the Rangers. Wedgewood has won his past three starts.
