

**FLAMES LAST GAME RECAP****November 3, 2024 – CALGARY FLAMES [2] vs. EDMONTON OILERS [4]**[Game Summary](#) | [Event Summary](#)

The Calgary Flames welcomed the Edmonton Oilers to the Scotiabank Saddledome on Sunday night for round two of the Battle of Alberta. The visitors would open the scoring 20 seconds into the contest, before doubling their advantage midway through the opening frame to lead 2-0 through 20. Calgary would get one back in the middle stanza with Anthony Mantha deflecting a Tyson Barrie shot home, and the Flames trailed 2-1 through 40. Yegor Sharangovich brought the Flames back to level terms 4:28 into the third with his first of the season. Edmonton would reclaim the lead midway through the third and add an empty netter to knock off Calgary 4-2.

TONIGHTS STORYLINES & STATS

This is the first of two meetings this season between the Flames and the Canadiens. Calgary swept the season-series against Montreal in 2023-24, outscoring the Canadiens 7-3.

This is a Pacific Division versus Atlantic Division matchup; the Flames have a record of 0-0-0 against Atlantic Division teams and a record of 3-1-0 against Eastern Conference opponents.

LAST SEASON VERSUS MONTREAL:

The Calgary Flames and Montreal Canadiens met twice last season, with the Flames winning both meetings. Meeting number one came on November 14th, 2023 where Connor Zary recorded his first multi-point game in the NHL with a goal and an assist and also recorded his first NHL game-winning goal. Nazem Kadri also scored for Calgary as the Flames knocked off the Canadiens 2-1 in meeting number one. Their second matchup came on March 16th, 2024 where Dustin Wolf made 36 saves along with a pair of goals and an assist from Mikael Backlund in a 5-2 Flames win. MacKenzie Weegar had three assists on the night, while Jonathan Huberdeau (0-2 – 2) and Nazem Kadri (1-1 – 1) also recorded multi-point games in the winning effort.

SHARKNADO:

Yegor Sharangovich scored his first of the season on Sunday night against Edmonton. Sharangovich finished the 2023-24 season with a career-best 31 goals to become the first player of Belarusian descent to score 30-or-more goals in a single season. Sharangovich's 59 points made him the all-time highest scoring Belarusian in a single season. Mikhail Grabovski previously held the record with 58 points from 29 goals and 29 assists during the 2010-11 campaign as a member of the Toronto Maple Leafs.

SAVE THE BEST FOR LAST:

In the final frame of Sunday night's matchup against the Oilers, Yegor Sharangovich scored the Flames 18th third-period goal of the 2024-25 campaign. Coming into tonight's contest only the New Jersey Devils (19), the Los Angeles Kings (20) the Vegas Golden Knights (21) and Winnipeg Jets (23) have recorded more third-period goals so far this season.

LOOK BACKS AT IT:

In Calgary and Montreal's last meeting on March 16th, Mikael Backlund scored a pair of goals to record the 199th and 200th NHL goals of his career. Backlund became the 11th player in franchise history to reach the 200-goal plateau, and just the second Swedish-born skater in Flames history to reach 200 goals, joining Kent Nilsson (229). The Flames captain just recently skated in his 1,000th NHL game to become just the second skater in Flames franchise history to skate in 1,000 games for the club.

HUBY DOO:

Jonathan Huberdeau currently has 498 assists in his NHL career, and with two more helpers Huberdeau can join Nikita Kucherov and Johnny Gaudreau as one of just three players from the 2011 NHL draft to reach the 500-assist mark and become the 25th-active skater to achieve the feat.

HEY DID YOU KNOW?



Anthony Mantha scored the first two goals of his NHL career against the Montreal Canadiens on Mar. 24th 2016 and Mar. 29th, 2016.

MacKenzie Weegar played his first NHL game against the Montreal Canadiens back on April 3rd of 2017.

Canadiens Head Coach Martin St. Louis played 69 games as a member of the Calgary Flames over two seasons, scoring four goals and 16 assists for 20 points as a Flame.

Mikael Backlund needs one assist to tie Guy Chouinard and Paul Reinhart (both w/ 336) for the seventh most in franchise history.
