TEAM NOTES

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP

● The Maple Leafs are set to face-off against the Edmonton Oilers tonight at Scotiabank Arena in the first of two games between the clubs this season. The Maple Leafs posted a 1-1-0 record against the Oilers in the 2023-24 season while posting a 7-2-1 record through their last 10 games. Toronto has posted a 7-3-0 record on home ice this season, tying for the third most home wins in the league this season with seven.

LAST GAME

● The Maple Leafs won a 4-3 overtime decision against the Washington Capitals on Wednesday night at Capital One Arena. John Tavares scored the game-winning goal at 4:13 of overtime, scoring his ninth goal of the season and the 18th overtime goal of his NHL career. Bobby McMann, William Nylander and Mitch Marner (PP) also scored a goal each in Toronto's win. Oliver Ekman-Larsson skated in the 1,000th game of his NHL career with the Maple Leafs on Wednesday. Ekman-Larsson became the 26th skater and ninth defenceman to play his 1,000th game as a member of the Maple Leafs. Jani Hakanpää skated in his Maple Leafs debut. Joseph Woll stopped 24 of 27 shots he faced in Toronto's overtime win.
