PLAYER NOTES

- Max Domi scored for the Maple Leafs at 10:32 of the first period and posted the primary assist on Matthews' goal. With the goal, Domi recorded his first playoff point as a Maple Leaf. Domi marked the sixth multi-point game of his Stanley Cup playoff career. Per NHL Stats, "Max and Tie Domi are the ninth father-son duo to each score a playoff goal for the same franchise. The others are Ken & Ken Hodge Jr. (w/ BOS), Gordie & Mark Howe (w/ HFD & DET), Gordie & Marty Howe (w/ HFD), Peter & Paul Stastny (w/ COL/QUE), Mike & Patrick Eaves (w/ DAL/MNS), Butch & Pierre Bouchard (w/ MTL), Greg & Ryan Malone (w/ PIT) and Mike & B.J. Crombeen (w/ STL)."
- **John Tavares** scored on a Maple Leafs power play opportunity at 18:26 of the second period. Tavares scored his first goal of the 2024 Stanley Cup Playoffs and 23rd goal of his Stanley Cup playoff career.
- Auston Matthews scored the game-winning goal for Toronto at 12:06 of the third period, posted the lone assist on Domi's goal and the primary assist on Tavares' power play goal. Matthews recorded the sixth game-winning goal of his Stanley Cup playoff career, tying him for fourth on the franchise all-time list for most game-winning goals scored in the playoffs. Matthews tied a single-game Stanley Cup playoff career-high in points with three (1G, 2A), which he has marked on four occasions during his playoff career. With the fourth three-point game of his Stanley Cup playoff career, Matthews tied for third on the franchise all-time list for most three-point games recorded during the playoffs. Matthews also tied a single-game Stanley Cup playoff career-high in assists with two which he has marked on six occasions during his playoff career. With 16 face-off wins tonight, Matthews tied a single-game Stanley Cup playoff career second-best.
- **Tyler Bertuzzi** posted the secondary assist on Tavares' power play goal. With the assist, Bertuzzi recorded his first playoff point as a Maple Leaf and the sixth assist of his Stanley Cup playoff career.
- **Ilya Lyubushkin** recorded the secondary assist on Matthews' goal. Lyubushkin recorded his first assist of the 2024 Stanley Cup Playoffs and the second assist of his Stanley Cup playoff career.
- Ilya Samsonov stopped 27 of 29 shots he faced in tonight's win.
- Morgan Rielly was on the ice for a team-high 27 Toronto shot attempts-for at 5-on-5.
- **Nicholas Robertson** finished the game with a team-high 5-on-5 shot attempt percentage of 70.00 percent (7 for, 3 against).

TEAM NOTES

- The Maple Leafs were 1-for-3 on the power play and 1-for-2 on the penalty kill tonight.
- At 16:57 of the second period, video review was initiated to determine whether a high stick was used on the play that resulted in Toronto's goal. Per the NHL's Situation Room, "Video review determined that Tyler Bertuzzi's stick was above the height of the crossbar when he directed the puck into the Boston net. According to Rule 78.5 (vi) that states in part "Apparent goals shall be disallowed by the Referee . . . When the puck has entered the net after making contact with an attacking player's stick that is above the height of the crossbar. Where the puck makes contact with the stick is the determining factor." Result: Call on the ice is overturned No goal Toronto
