

A Message from Reading Is Cool

Dear Parents & Guardians,

Your child's classroom is currently participating in Reading Is Cool, a free literacy program from the San Jose Sharks. This program is a fun and effective way to instill the importance of reading in youth. Reading Is Cool incorporates several components that come together to encourage students to achieve success both individually and as a classroom "team".

Your child is participating in the incentive component of the program which asks students to track the number of pages they read each month. At the end of the month, your student's teacher will submit the class total and S.J. Sharkie, the San Jose Sharks mascot, will visit the classroom of each grade that reads the most. Also, the teacher will award an "All-Star Reader" medal to the student they feel was the top reader based on number of pages read, greatest improvement, or hardest effort.

San Jose Sharks encourages parents, siblings, and other family members to support their student by reading and tracking pages together at home. Please ask your child about their participation in the program and encourage your child to track their progress on the downloadable reading log. Because we believe in sharing the power of a book with others, please note:

- K-2nd Grade students may also count books that are read to them, at home, or in school.
- 3rd-5th Grade students may count "easy" books that they read to a sibling or younger child.
