TONIGHT'S MATCHUP

● The Maple Leafs are scheduled to face-off against the Chicago Blackhawks tonight at Scotiabank Arena in the first of two games between the clubs this season. Toronto posted a 0-1-1 record against Chicago during the 2023-24 season while posting a 4-5-1 record through their last 10 meetings. With Toronto's matchup tonight against the Blackhawks, the Maple Leafs begin a three-game homestand. Toronto has posted a 10-3-0 record at Scotiabank Arena this season, currently tied for the league lead in wins on home ice with 10. The Maple Leafs have captured a win in five of their last six games while earning a point in nine of their last 11 games (8-2-1).

LAST GAME

● The Maple Leafs won 5-3 against the Tampa Bay Lightning on Saturday night at Amalie Arena. John Tavares scored the game-winning goal for Toronto with Chris Tanev scoring his first as a Maple Leaf. Matthew Knies, Nicholas Robertson and William Nylander also scored a goal each in Toronto's win. Four different Maple Leaf skaters earned two point for Toronto, with Auston Matthews and Mitch Marner each recording two assists while Knies (1G, 1A) posted the ninth multi-point game of his NHL career and Tanev (1G, 1A) marked the 20th multi-point game of his NHL career. Jake McCabe skated in the 600th game of his NHL career. Joseph Woll stopped 38 of 41 shots he faced in Saturday's win. Woll has earned a win in five-consecutive starts.
