- The Stars will not skate before their flight to Nashville on Friday, Dec. 22.

NOTES

- Forward **Matt Duchene** (1-1—2) recorded his 12th career overtime-winning goal as part of a multi-point performance in Dallas' 4-3 victory against Vancouver. Duchene leads the NHL in game winners (6) and shares second on the Stars in goals (11).

With 29 points (11-18—29) in 30 GP, Duchene has the most points by a player skating for a new team this season. (Detroit's Alex DeBrincat has 15-13—28 in 32 GP and Chicago's Connor Bedard has 12-16—28 in 31 GP.
Defenseman Thomas Harley scored the game-tying goal with 3:30 remaining in regulation as part of a multi-point night (1-1—2) to extend his point streak to a career-best four straight games (3-2—5). The 22-year-old shares the league lead in goals among defensemen (9) and ranks second among Stars blueliners in points (9-6—15) in 28 GP.
Defenseman Miro Heiskanen (48-179—227) passed Lou Nanne (225) for sole possession of the ninth most points by a defenseman in franchise history. Heiskanen has points in four of his past five games (3-4—7) and 23 points (4-19—23) overall, tops among Stars blueliners.

- Heiskanen (179) also passed **Craig Hartsburg** (177) for the most assists before age 25 by a defenseman in franchise history.

- Forward **Tyler Seguin** reached double digits in goals with his 10th tally of the season. Seguin has reached 10 goals or more in 14 of his 15 seasons in the NHL. (He only played three games in 2020-21). Seguin has points in five consecutive games (1-4—5) and 23 points (10-13—23) in 31 GP.

- Forward **Roope Hintz** (1-0–1) tallied his 11th goal of the season, second most on the Stars. Hintz' goal gave him points in two in a row (1-1–2) and in five of his past six (3-4–7).

- Forward **Joe Pavelski's** assist gave him his team-leading 30th point (13-17—30) of the season (31 GP). With 1,031 points (462-569—1,031), Pavelski is two points shy of tying **Doug Weight** for seventh on the all-time points list among U.S.-born skaters.

- Forward **Jason Robertson** continues to lead the Stars in assists after recording two helpers on Thursday vs. Vancouver. Robertson shares the team lead in points (10-20—30) and has found the scoresheet in four of his past five games (2-4—6).

- Goaltender **Scott Wedgewood** made 17 saves on 20 shots, including a game-saving stop on a 2-on-0 in overtime. With the win, Wedgewood improved to 8-1-2 overall this season.
