

Book Jackets is designed to be a flexible tool that encourages healthy reading habits by rewarding your students for reading outside the classroom. - Student scorecards (K-5 & 6-8)

Your classroom and individual students can earn the following Book Jackets prizes for completing the 4-week Book Jackets program and submitting total minutes read.

- Upon submitting their minutes read, all students will receive their incentives for completing the program.
- Classrooms will be automatically entered to win a classroom visit from the Blue Jackets mascot, Stinger.

# BOOK JACKETS IS DESIGNED TO BE FLEXIBLE AND EASY TO USE.

The program can be run over any four-week period from August 2025-May 2026. Once you have selected your program time frame, follow the instructions below to implement Book Jackets in your classroom.

- **1.** Download and/or print the student scorecard and parent letter to send home with students at the start of the program.
- **2.** Determine a classroom reading goal. Share the classroom goal and individual reading goals with your students and their parents.
  - Our recommended classroom goals are between 2,250-10,500 minutes for K-5 grade and 3,750-15,000 minutes for 6-8 grade classes over the 4-week program.
- **3.** Have students, with the help of their parents, use the student scorecard to record how many minutes they read or have read to them outside of the classroom each day.
- **4.** Check in with your students and update your classroom poster throughout the 4-week period.
- **5.** At the end of your four weeks, visit BlueJackets.com/BookJackets to submit your classroom results.
- **6.** Prizes will be sent to you within four weeks of your submission.

- April 3: Last day to register for Book Jackets for the 2025-26 school year.
- May 4: Program deadline for all reading minute submissions.
