
Erik Karlsson tallied his 13th assist of the season on Wednesday night, which leads all team defensemen and ranks second on the Penguins overall.

SILENCE THE CANNON

The Penguins face the Columbus Blue Jackets tonight in the first of two visits to Nationwide Arena this season.

- The Penguins have earned points in 16 of their last 17 games played against the Blue Jackets, going 12-1-4 since December 12, 2019.
- Pittsburgh's success has been due in large part to Sidney Crosby, who has only been held off the scoresheet three times against Columbus in that same span, tallying a total of 30 points [12G-18A].
- In NHL history, only two players have more assists and points against the Blue Jackets than Sidney Crosby, who has 21 goals, 44 assists and 65 points in 46 games:
