Oilers Stars

- The Stars responded to a Game 1 loss with a win in Game 2 for the sixth time since 2020 tied with the Oilers for the most Game 2 victories following a loss over that span.
- Forward **Mason Marchment** (1-0—1) became the seventh different Stars player with a game-winning goal in the 2024 Stanley Cup Playoffs. The only other postseasons where the franchise has featured more individuals with a winner is 2020, 2000, 1999, 1998 and 1991 (all with eight).
- Captain **Jamie Benn** (1-0—1) recorded his 72nd career postseason point (27-45—72) to tie **Sergei Zubov** (72) for the fifth-most playoff points in franchise history. Benn extended his point streak to three consecutive games (2-1—3).
- Defenseman **Miro Heiskanen** (0-1—1) registered his team-leading 14th point (5-9—14) of the playoffs with an assist in the first period. With his 44th career postseason assist, Heiskanen surpassed **Sebastian Aho** for sole possession of sixth most by a Finnish-born player **Jari Kurri** (127) paces the list. Heiskanen co-leads d-men in the 2024 postseason in goals (5), ranks third in points (5-9—14) and fourth in assists (9) in 15 GP.
- Forward **Wyatt Johnston** (0-2—2) recorded his fourth multi-point game of the 2024 playoffs to give him 13 points (7-6—13) in 15 GP.
- Goaltender **Jake Oettinger** improved to 15-7-2 following a loss of any kind in the regular season and playoffs combined in 2023-24. The only goaltenders with more such victories are **Juuse Saros** (18), **Jordan Binnington** (16) and **Igor Shesterkin** (16). Oettinger earned his 22nd career playoff win to move into sole possession of second on the franchise's all-time playoff wins list, behind only **Ed Belfour** (44).
